*“Jesus understands every weakness of ours, because he was tempted in every way that we are. But he did not sin! So whenever we are in need, we should come bravely before the throne of our merciful God. There we will be treated with undeserved kindness, and we will find help.”* (Hebrews 4:15-16 CEV)

Passover and Communion are reminders that God understands our needs and provides solutions.

Exodus 1:8-22 and 3:1-10

- ✓ God understood their captivity to the Egyptians
- ✓ God understood their inability to do anything

God stepped in and provided a way to do what they couldn't do and give them life, freedom and a future.

- ✓ They experienced Passover one time (Exodus 12:1-13)
- ✓ They celebrated Passover many times (Exodus 12:14)

- III. Passover was a time to remember what it took to provide a future

- ✓ God understood our captivity to our sin (Romans 3:23)
- ✓ God understood our inability to do anything (Romans 5:6-8)

- ✓ We experience salvation one time (Jesus called it being “Born Again”)
- ✓ We celebrate salvation many times
