

# HARCOURTS CANCER SOCIETY BALL 2018

## TICKETING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### All tables of 10 include:

- Entry to the 2018 Harcourts Cancer Society Ball
- 3 course meal
- Access to the open bar in the Ballroom serving a range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages
- Live entertainment across the night
- The opportunity to contribute greatly to a cause that touches us all – through the Cancer Society Canterbury / West Coast Division

### Additionally, Premium Tables also receive:

- 3 x bottles of complimentary Mumm champagne to their table across the evening
- Preferential seating in the Ballroom (front three rows closest to the MC stage – as marked up on the map)

### EARLY BIRD PRE-SALE

A limited amount of tables are available for a discounted rate via Early Bird Pre-Sale from Thursday 8th March, 12pm. To receive a 10% discount on table price, table buyers must enter the promo code EARLY BIRD when purchasing online. Once the allocation of Early Bird tables has been exhausted, Early Bird code will no longer be applicable and sales will cease. From 3 April, remaining tables will go back on sale at full price.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. No food or beverages may be taken into the event.
2. Table location is non-negotiable and non-transferrable, the table you select upon purchase will be the table you are seated at on the night. Unless –
  - a. You negotiate directly with another table buyer and directly arrange a swap for table placement. And notify the Cancer Society via email prior to two weeks before the event [ball@cancercwc.org.nz](mailto:ball@cancercwc.org.nz).
  - b. There is a situation out of the control of the event organisers that require the table placement / seating plan to be rearranged. If this is the case, the affected table buyers will be notified by email and no refund will be available.

3. All table purchases are non-refundable, other than in the instance of a full cancellation of the event.
4. In the event of a natural disaster, or a situation outside of the control of the Cancer Society, the event may be cancelled. In the event of a full cancellation, table buyers are welcome to apply for a refund (either full or partial) by emailing [ball@cancercwc.org.nz](mailto:ball@cancercwc.org.nz) (an administration fee will apply). Alternatively, as the event is for such a worthy cause, in this situation we would also invite ticket holders to generously forgo their refund, in which case their ticket cost (minus the administration fee) would be donated directly to the Cancer Society Canterbury-West Coast Division.
5. Table purchases may be transferred into a different name prior to two weeks before the event. However, all money exchanges for the table must happen directly by table seller/buyer. Any change in table ownership must be made prior to two weeks before the event and the Cancer Society must be notified by email [ball@cancercwc.org.nz](mailto:ball@cancercwc.org.nz).
6. Artist line-up and billed attractions may be subject to change.
7. Right of Admission Reserved – In order to facilitate the security, safety and comfort of all guests the Organiser reserves the right to refuse admission without refund of ticket price.
8. Admission is at Ticket Holders own risk. The Organiser will not be held liable for any loss, injuries or damages sustained at this event including damage, theft or losses to property and motor vehicles, if the cause is due to the negligence of the ticket holder or the unforeseeable actions of other patrons.
9. A condition of entry to the ball is ticket holders consenting to being filmed and/or photographed for use in television, video, social media or printed promotional material.
10. The Ticket Holder consents to and will permit the search and inspection of his or her person, clothing, bags or other possessions by any official, employee of the proprietor of the venue and/or the organizer of the event.
11. All tickets purchased through Eventopia shall be subject to a booking fee (included within the table price), and any credit card processing fees.
12. The Ticket Holder may be required to provide proof of age when served alcohol. This must take the form of one of the following types of identification: A HANZ Card, a New Zealand Drivers License, New Zealand or Foreign Passport
13. The Ticket Holder will be required to leave the venue if he or she: Engages in conduct which unreasonably interferes with the enjoyment of the event by the patrons; hampers or impedes the conduct of the event; breaches any by-laws or orders applicable to the venue

- 14.** Ticket Holders agree that it is an essential condition of issuance of Tickets and the right of admission to the event conferred on the Ticket Holder that any person at, or entering, or attempting to enter, the Venue is expressly prohibited from:
- a.** Holding or bringing any prohibited or restricted items (to be assessed at the discretion of the security and management) including, without limitation; alcohol; illicit drugs; knives; weapons; fireworks; glass; cans; bottles; compressed gas containers; political, religious, offensive or race-related banners, signs, slogans or materials; flares; air horns; sound amplifiers including loudhailers; toy guns or water pistols; smoke bombs and flag sticks; commercial standard recording devices; dogs or other pets; laser pointers; skateboards, roller blades, scooters or bicycles; or items that may interfere with the enjoyment, comfort or safety of other persons or security at the Venue (“Prohibited Items”);
  - b.** Engaging in disruptive or dangerous behaviour including, without limitation; throwing, casting, thrusting or firing any objects; instigating violence, racism or xenophobia; behaving in a way that others may interpret as provocative, threatening, discriminatory, or offensive; creating any threat to the life or safety of themselves or others, or harming another person in any way whatsoever.
