SB 190

The electric grid is the backbone of Missouri's economy and by working together we can spur economic development as we build a smarter, stronger energy grid for Missouri consumers!

This is why we support making minor adjustments to our energy regulations. By making these small changes, Missouri can update 100 year-old policies, while boosting economic development, supporting our state's future energy needs and creating jobs by building the next generation of smart grid infrastructure. Additionally, for every \$1.00 invested in grid modernization, customers would receive a benefit/savings of \$2.40.
