

Girls' Youth Ministry Assistant - The River Church

Job Description

The River Church is seeking a Girls' Youth Ministry Assistant to aid in the discipleship of our middle school and high school girls (grades 6-12). This position will primarily be responsible for discipling girls currently in our youth group, reaching out to the friends of our youth (outside of The River), and taking the lead on planning/facilitating regular fun, youth-oriented events.

Explanation

Over the past several years our youth group at The River has steadily grown from 4-5 active members to 10-12 who regularly attend weekly youth meetings. The potential is there however, for us to bring in many more. We have several students attending and outside of The River, who are involved occasionally. At a few events we have had 20+ youth. With the right person to assist our Director of Student Ministries, we believe that we can get several more of these students involved regularly, and have a greater impact on the youth outside of our church walls. We are especially looking for someone who is passionate about forming relationships with and discipling middle and high school girls, both on a 1-on-1 basis and in small groups. The right person will be able to help students grow and mature in their faith while also reaching out to their friends who are outside the River. We also envision this person taking the lead on developing fun events on a regular basis to create more energy and momentum in the youth program as a whole.

Estimated Time

8 hours/week.

Primary Responsibilities (estimated hrs/wk)

- 1-on-1 and small group discipleship of middle and high school aged girls. (1.5)
- Contact work with youth outside of The River (especially friends of River youth) (1.5)
- Planning and implementation of larger events (approx. every 4-6 weeks during the school year) (1.0)
- Regular attendance and assistance at weekly Sunday youth meeting and Sunday worship (2.0)
- Weekly coordination/check-in with Director of Student Ministries and/or River staff meetings (1.0)
- Admin/Other (1.0)

Expectations

- Attend Sunday worship at The River at least 2/4 Sundays per month (Worship services will not count as paid time, though job-related meetings before or after the service will)
- Attend weekly youth meetings (Sundays, 4:30-6:30; this counts as paid time).
- Ideal candidate would be present over the summer and would attend Camp Booyah (this time would not be paid hourly, but cost of attendance would be paid by The River).
- Minimum one-year commitment; two-year commitment preferred.
- Must have and be able to articulate a strong Christian faith.

Compensation

Pay is hourly, based on experience, received bi-monthly. This position will also include a stipend for ministry-related expenses.
