

DRESS CODE

Toddler Dance

- Toddlers and parents wear comfortable clothing (i.e. leggings, sweatpants, shorts) and toddlers dance barefoot or with Cynthia King Ballet Slippers™

Ballet and Pre-K Dance

- Girls: leotard (solid color, no designs/embellishments, no skirts) and tights
- Boys: studio t-shirt with leggings, dance pants
- Cynthia King Ballet Slippers™ required
- Students in Ballet 1 and higher must wear their hair in a bun or have braids neatly pulled back. Beads must be secured with a net or scarf.

Tap, Jazz, Modern, & African Dance

- Girls: leotard (solid color, no designs/embellishments, no skirts) with tights or leggings
- Boys: studio t-shirt with leggings, dance pants
- Tappers wear synthetic tap shoes. Jazz, Modern, and African dancers are barefoot

Hip-Hop / B-Boy / Breakdancing

- Studio t-shirt with leggings, dance pants, or sweatpants
- Synthetic, clean-bottom sneakers (that are only worn in class and not outdoors)

Dance Companies

- Assigned leotard, tights, and skirt (if applicable)
- Cynthia King Ballet Slippers™ required for Ballet. During Modern dance class, students dance barefoot
- Assigned Company colors:
 - Junior Company – Mulberry**
 - Ensemble Company – Red/Scarlet**
 - Repertory Company 1 – Burgundy**
 - Repertory Company 2 – Teal**
 - Pre-Professional – Forest Green**
 - Pre-Professional Corps – Black**

Note

- Students who identify as gender non-conforming may choose the dress code they are most comfortable with.
