Please prepare and submit the following with your application:

1. **A Personal Statement:** We want to know who you are. Please submit a personal statement of approximately 150 - 200 words. This statement should be typed or legibly written on a piece of standard 8.5 X 11" paper. Feel free to write about what interests you. For instance; what are you curious and passionate about? What soaring heights do you see yourself achieving? Why do you sing, act, write, take photos and/or play an instrument(s)? What do you think you'll learn from being accepted to our program? What would you build if you only had the following items at your disposal: a deck of cards, a box of paperclips, a mile of guitar strings, five bamboo window shades, or whatever you have in your pockets or bag right now? Whatever you decide to write about, please take some chances and don't repeat your resume. In the end, please connect back to why you would benefit from attending the *Expanding Horizons College Preparatory Program*.

2. **A Resume:** Please list your educational background and any work experience, whether in the arts or not. Don't be shy about your accomplishments and/or involvement in theatrical/musical productions, even if it was/is ensemble work and/or you were/are a member of the stage crew.

3. **Two Letters of Recommendation.** Applicants are strongly encouraged to ask recommenders who have taught them or supervised their work. These recommendations should come from the two references listed on the application.
