5:00am – Report time (Equipment will be loaded onto semi the night before during the football game); Dress into bibbers.

5:20am – Meet in band room and then load buses; Make sure you have everything you need!

5:30am – Depart HSE for Muncie, IN

6:40am – Arrive at Scheumann Stadium in Muncie, IN; Unload/Dress into Uniform

7:40am – Transit to Warm-Up Area B

7:55am – Music and Physical Warm-Up

8:35am – Pit Staging Time

8:40am – Band Transits to Staging

8:50am – Band Staging

9:00am – PERFORMANCE – HAVE A GREAT SHOW!!!!

9:15am – Return to buses to load/change out of uniform

10:00am – Return to stadium to watch bands (Bring \$\$ for concessions for lunch!!) Sit together in the stands.

4:30pm – Awards/Announcement of Finalist Bands

5:00pm – Eat pizza in parking lot (provided) then the schedule is TBA depending on whether we are performing at Finals or watching (Bring extra concession \$\$ and/or more food and snacks from home.)

10:30pm – Awards

11:30pm – Approximate time of departure from Muncie

12:30am – Approximate time of arrival at HSE; Unload

PLEASE NOTE:

- You must remain on campus at HSE and/or our contest site for the entire day. You must not leave the campus for any reason, as that is a safety concern! You must ride the buses to/from the contest.
- Be respectful and listen at all times to adult contest workers, chaperones, prop crew, parents, staff, contest officials, etc.
- You must represent your school, your community and yourself with pride and dignity.
- Act professionally on Saturday from the moment you arrive at HSE until the dismissal time.
- Follow Section Leader and Drum Major instructions.
- Make sure you have your parade t-shirt, gym shorts, and LONG black socks to wear underneath your uniform, as well as your marching shoes.
- Uniform Reminders – Hair is to be completely pinned up in shako. No jewelry is to be worn in uniform; No nail polish if fingernails are visible.
- Wear your parade t-shirt when not in uniform, so that we can identify where everyone is located.
- You are responsible for bringing your own instrument, as well as mouthpiece, extra reeds, and anything else you need. Please do not expect anyone to load/unload your equipment for you.

- As you watch bands, visit the concession stand, use the restrooms, etc. make sure that you are in **GROUPS OF 3 OR MORE AT ALL TIMES!**
