Volunteer Code of Conduct

1. Read and abide by the bylaws, standing rules and volunteer handbook.
2. Act with professionalism, discretion, and integrity in all areas of my position.
3. Give complete respect to all competing bands (their staff, students and parents) by not initiating or participating in any discussions that are critical or derogatory.
4. Give respect to the board members and volunteers of the BBB by not initiating or participating in any discussions that are critical or derogatory.
5. Initiate change to the BBB organization by communicating suggestions, problems or concerns with the President or another board member.
6. Respect other board members and volunteers by allowing them to execute their positions without criticism. If it appears gross negligence is occurring in a position, I will report that to the President or another board member.
7. Avoid initiation of or participation in derogatory discussions regarding the Bentonville band staff, students, or performances.
8. Protect confidential information that may be disclosed as part of my position (i.e. student disciplinary actions, student health issues, financial information). This information will not be discussed.
9. Shall not misuse the authority of a position that allows the distribution of earning potential for students by showing favoritism to any student or myself.
10. Steer clear of distribution of any written communication without the approval of the President and the Supervisor of Instrumental Music (i.e. flyers, emails, handouts).
