Fairgrounds Concession Agreement 2022

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It is our pleasure to invite you to participate in this year's 167th Spencerville Fair, being held from Thursday September 8 to Sunday September 11, 2022.

Despite this time of change and uncertainty, we, the Spencerville Agricultural Society, are continuing to offer our community stability. Like you, we are still facing the same challenges as the last two years. However, we have been successful, thanks to the help of our sponsors, volunteers, and the community of Eastern Ontario. With the virtual fair in 2021 and the hybrid/virtual fair last year, we were able to reach a whole new audience, putting our fair on the multi-provincial map.

Though this year will also be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, our willingness to push forward has not wavered. We are working to ensure the same quality of fun and devotion, as well as the true spirit of the Spencerville Fair that is always expected from us. This year the fair will feature the midway, exhibit hall, livestock shows, family entertainment and much more.

As our food vendors are an essential part of our fair, we ask you to help us give our community what they are waiting for. And to help you as a <u>food vendor</u> to overcome the 2 very challenging years, <u>we are inviting you to join us this year without charge</u>. Your only expense will be hydro, which we have kept at the 2019 level despite the increased hydro cost. All other vendors will pay a reduced rate.

Of course, if you have a successful time at our fair, we'd be happy to accept a donation to the Spencerville Agricultural Society at the end of your stay.

Concessions General Rules & Regulations

- All spots will be allocated by Spencerville Agricultural Society Concession committee.
- In consideration of being granted a permit to use the specified space of the Spencerville Agricultural Society / George Drummond Memorial Grounds (hereinafter called Spencerville Fair) the Undersigned (hereinafter called the Licensee) agrees to all the terms, conditions and covenants herein contained.
- NO concessions will be permitted on the Fairgrounds without receipt of payment in full, Insurance Certificate, and signed contract.
- Rental is for the concession only. Additional vehicles may only be parked in designated parking areas. <u>Grey wastewater only</u>, must be disposed of in designated areas provided.
- The Spencerville Fair, its Directors, Committee Members or Employees shall not be responsible
 in any way for any injury to any person, or for loss or damage to any property belonging to the
 Licensee.

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Vendor Licensee is responsible for providing Spencerville Fair / George Drummond Memorial Fairgrounds with a Certificate of Insurance indicating a minimum of \$2,000,000 public liability insurance and naming Spencerville Fair / George Drummond Memorial Fairgrounds as an additional named insured. All other vendors must provide proof of \$2,000,000 public liability insurance or equivalent amount in their homeowner's policy.

Hours of Operation: Thursday 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm – in place by 3:00 pm

Friday 10:00 am to 11:00 pm – in place by 9:00 am Saturday 10:00 am to 11:00 pm – in place by 9:00 am Sunday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm – in place by 9:00 am

No tear down will be allowed prior to 4:00 pm on Sunday.

There will be a mandatory concession meeting in the dining tent at 9:00 am <u>on Friday</u>. <u>One representative must be present for every vendor.</u>

Food vendors are responsible for the daily cleaning of the dining tent.

There will be no traffic movement during Fair hours. All restocking of concessions must be done between 7:00 am and 9:00 am. Parking will be strictly monitored. Any vehicle on the grounds not displaying a parking pass while restocking will be towed. There will be no parking of stock vehicles behind allocated location. All stock trailers will be parked in the designated stock trailer area. All restocking must come through gate #3 only. Any deliveries showing up at other gates will be redirected to gate #3.

Hydro hookups will be available on Thursday September 12 at 12:00 pm. Hookups may be up to 60 feet from your location. It is the responsibility of each licensee to provide his or her own extension cord. All hydro equipment and connections must conform to the Electrical Safety Code and CSA Approved Standards. Garbage pickup will be curbside. Maximum 50 lbs. per bag. You are responsible to keep your area clean. All wiring must have Regular plugs, Male Twist Lock, or Male Stove Plugs. There will be no hard wiring. Any modification required by our electrician will start at \$100.00.

Please submit with your application a brief description of your display / menu (everything you will be selling). Food Vendors must provide a picture of their unit.

As a Community Fair we wish to assist other community organizations. Please do not hesitate to contact us for any special requests.

Spencerville Fair reserves the right to cancel this agreement at any time if, in our opinion, the terms and conditions of this license and the spirit of our Fair are not being observed.

The Spencerville Fair supports and promotes professionalism in our industry. Therefore, no vendor shall employ persons under the age of 14. No vendor shall consume or be under the influence of alcohol, marijuana, or any banned substance. All Board of Health Standards must be rigorously maintained. No vendor shall close or depart early. Please review the hours of operation to ensure compliance with your contractual obligations. No Knives, Laser Pointers, Fake Cigarettes, Lighters or smoking devices of any kind, Stink Bombs, Cap Guns, Firecrackers, or any other explosive devises TO BE SOLD! Non-compliance with contractual obligations will disqualify you from attending future fairs and may result in immediate expulsion with no refund from the Spencerville Fair.

Applications are due by August 15th, with a 50% deposit. Balance of payment is due by August 31st. Any application/payment received after August 31st will be subject to a surcharge. No application will be considered without payment, Insurance Certificate, and signed contract. You will receive your package with your passes upon arrival at the fairgrounds. Additional passes may be purchased for \$25.00 each. Tuesday September 10 after 10:00 am you may arrive to set up. Hydro is unable to be connected until Thursday September 12 at 12:00 pm. It will be disconnected at 5:00 pm on Sunday. Those concessions that arrive early and use power from other locations will be charged \$25.00/day. There will be absolutely no trailers parked in the ball diamond. All trailers/stock trucks will be parked in a designated area. We have a limited amount of power available to us - therefore we are not guaranteeing any power to campers. We recommend you bring your own generators.
