The goal of the program is to provide an avenue for Toronto wrestlers to feel supported in their journey, stay encouraged and be challenged to grow on and off the mat. Through practical online lessons and weekly communications, athletes will be provided an avenue to communicate back with coaches and mentors about how they are doing with wrestling, school, and in their personal life. In response, coaches, staff and mentors will be able to more carefully guide and support each athlete in their individual needs and address any arising issues or challenges. This will be achieved through personally meeting with the athlete, collaborating with personal coaches for ways to better guide and support the athlete, as well as subsidized access to professional services such as tutoring, counseling or medical care as needed.
