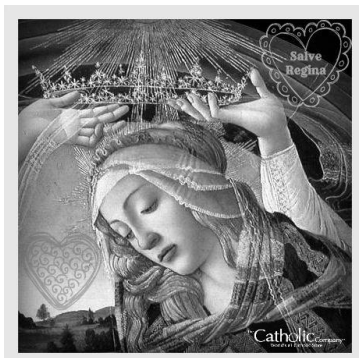

**FROM OUR PARISH ADMINISTRATOR**

“O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish.” In Matthew’s Gospel this week we have the story of a Canaanite woman coming to Jesus begging that her daughter be healed from the torments of a demon. This woman was a foreigner and it was the custom of the time for Jewish people to despise Canaanites because they were one of the ancient enemies of the Israelite people who prevented them from entering into the Promised Land. Jesus could have easily followed the cultural norms of the day and



ignored the woman’s cry for help but he rightly decides to heal the woman’s daughter from the demonic affliction. The important lesson to be learned from Jesus’ actions is that God wills the salvation of all peoples. Jesus has the wisdom to go against the false cultural norms of the time, so

that when the Canaanite woman approaches him and, by her faith, humility, and persistence, moves his heart, he changes his plans and heals the woman’s daughter.

In Christianity there is no such thing as a foreigner or outsider. God wills the salvation of all peoples no matter if they belong to Saint Columbkille Parish or not. The mission of the Church is to spread this good news by the manner in which we live our lives. We don’t help other people because they are Catholic. We help them because we are Catholic! I am so grateful for all the good deeds done in the name of Jesus Christ by members of our parish and you should be proud of all the people your generosity and prayers have helped.

Over the past five years, our parish in cooperation with all the other parishes in the Diocese of Cleveland, has been participating in the Rooted in Faith Forward in Hope Capital Campaign. On page five of the bulletin this week you’ll find an outline of the contributions raised by our parish along with a heartwarming story of just one of the many people who have benefited from your generosity. Thirty percent of the funds collected returned to Saint Columbkille over the past five years, which allowed us to complete many renovation and building projects such as installing new windows in the school and rectory, improve the sidewalks leading into the parish center and complete the park in front of the school. Our parish continues to receive quarterly distributions based upon the monies collected from your pledges.

God wills the salvation of all people and each one of you is called to be a missionary disciple, a lifelong learner of Jesus sent into the world to love like Christ, leading souls to Heaven. Please remember all of our

school children and teachers in your prayers as they begin a new year this week. On Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup> we welcome our grade school students and teachers for the first time to our parish 8:15 a.m. daily Mass. I am excited to have our students participating in Mass every week as a school community because there is no better way to know who Jesus is than by receiving his Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist!

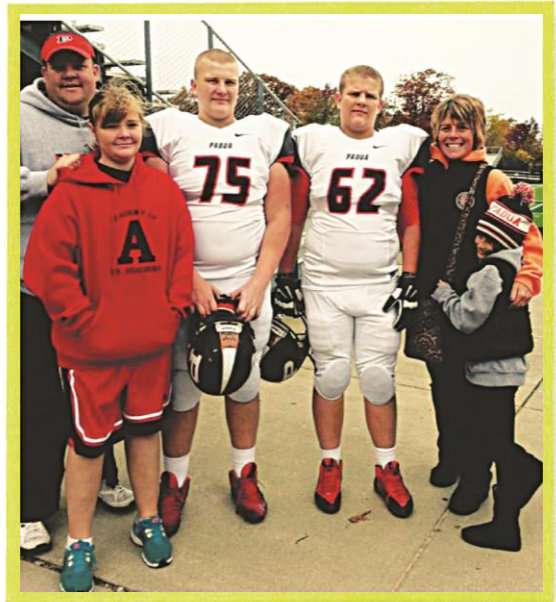

## Jack is Thriving!

In fifth grade, Jack's difficulties in school due to speech and learning disabilities started his family on a quest that took them out of Catholic schools to public school, and then to the Academy of St. Adalbert, where all students – including those with disabilities – learn side by side in the classroom.

"The level of engagement from the principal to the teachers was like nothing we had experienced before," says Jack's mother, Amy. "Jack no longer saw his disability as a negative, and he began to flourish in school." This foundation led to Jack's recent graduation from Padua Franciscan High School.



According to St. Adalbert principal, Susan Herman, *Rooted in Faith - Forward in Hope* grants have benefited all students. In February, the school was awarded a Catholic Education grant to fund "flexible seating," which allows teachers to accommodate student learning styles.

Seventy-four Catholic schools and parish catechetical programs received *Rooted in Faith - Forward in Hope* grants in February, totaling \$1,163,637. Funds were distributed at an event highlighting a bold new educational initiative to educate exceptional learners, like Jack, at Catholic schools in the Diocese. The Alleluia Ball, to be held October 14, 2017 at the Huntington Convention Center of Cleveland, will provide seed money for the new initiative, named "Better Together."

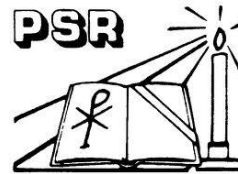
## BACK TO SCHOOL ICE CREAM SOCIAL
