Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- In charge of specimen collection, including patient preparation, labeling, handling, preservation or fixation, processing or preparation, transportation and storage of specimens
- Perform each test method and with proper instrument use
- Perform preventive maintenance, troubleshooting, and calibration procedures related to each test performed
- Implement quality control policies and all standard laboratory procedures
- Assess and verify the validity of patient test results through the evaluation of quality control sample values prior to reporting patient test results so must have an awareness of the factors that influence test results
- Maintain an inventory of supplies and reagents

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As a Laboratory Technician you will work closely with the Laboratory Director and you will report directly to the General Supervisor.

Expertise and Skills:

- Have a working knowledge of reagent stability and storage
- Ability to interact effectively with staff, work independently, work in harmony with other team members, and follow standard operating procedures and protocols
