ITEM ONE: The Board of Harbor Commissioners for Portland Harbor is proposing a change to the pilotage fees that may be charged by licensed pilots to vessels operating in Portland Harbor. Specifically, the Board is proposing a minimum pilotage fee of \$1,200.00 and a fee of \$7.18 per Pilot Unit (collectively, the "Proposed Pilotage Fees"). The Board is not proposing any changes to other fees.

The purpose of the hearing is to provide the Board with an opportunity to review all relevant information relating to a just and reasonable pilotage fee chargeable in the harbor and to allow public comment on the question.
