RE: July 12, 2018 Public Hearing

To Members of the Public and Interested Parties:

On July 12, 2018 the Board will hold a public hearing on a proposed change to its rules. Under the change being proposed, the Board would authorize the issuance of a limited number of mooring permits for Commercial Work Docks (defined to mean “a limited use dock, on a mooring(s), that is used exclusively for commercial lobstering purposes, including storage and servicing of lobster gear”) in Portland Harbor. The proposed rule will also add regulations and authorize mooring permit fees under Commission Rule 21.0 Mooring Regulations. The public hearing will take place on Thursday, July 12, 2018 at 5 p.m., Council Chambers, Portland City Hall.
