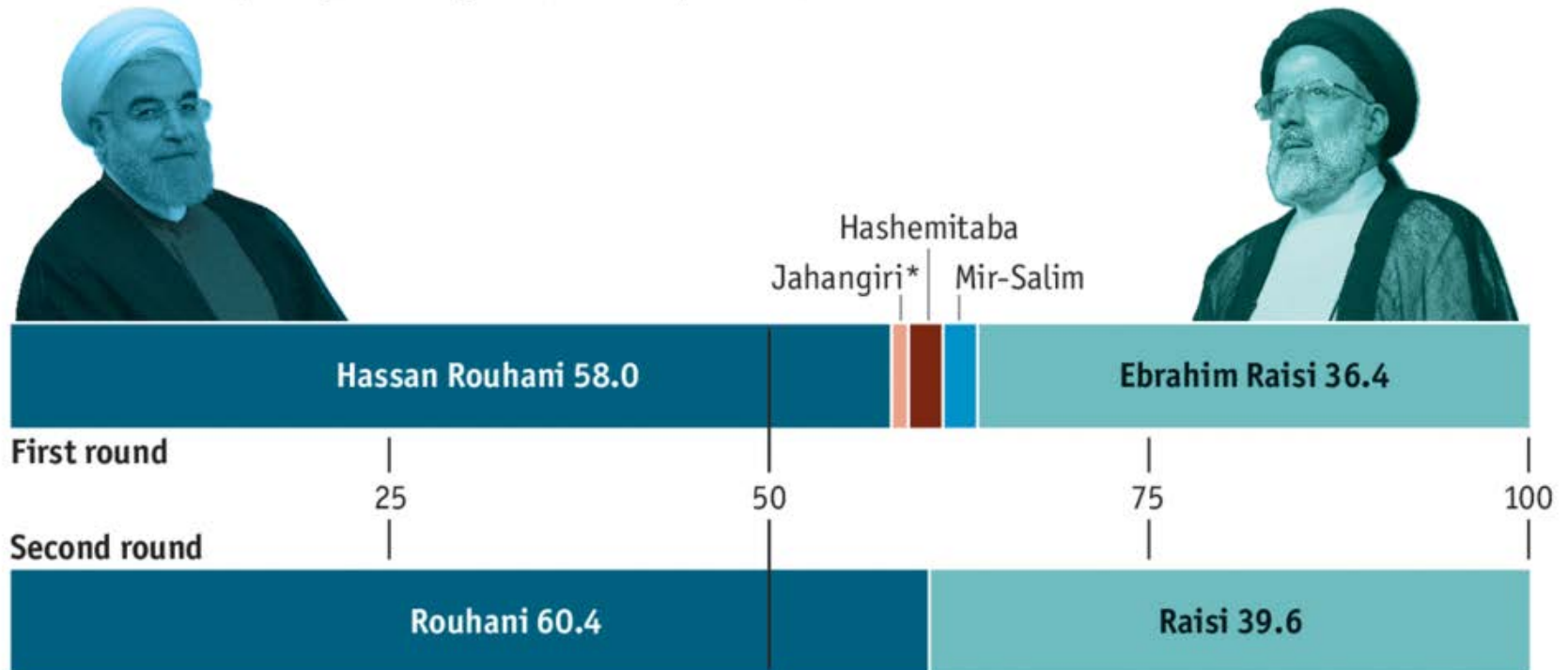

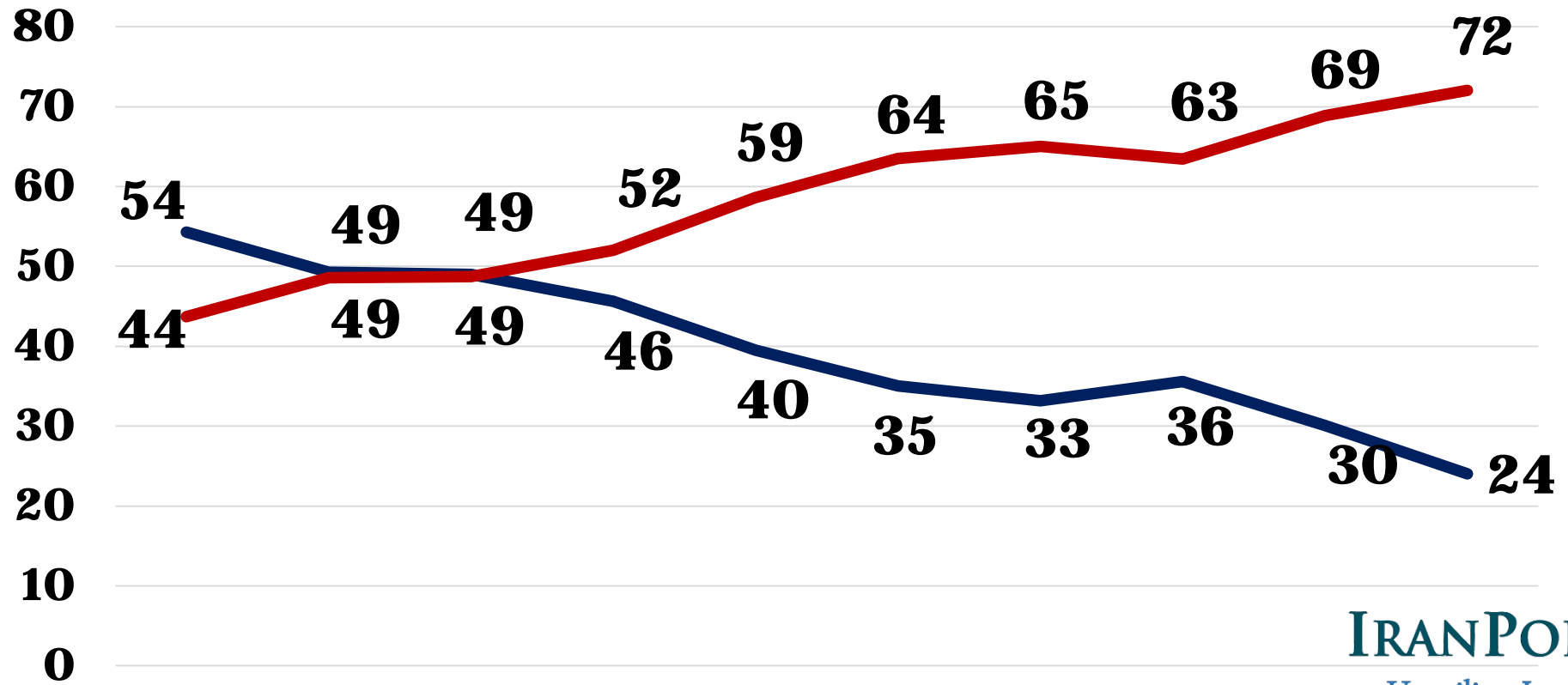

— Good — Bad



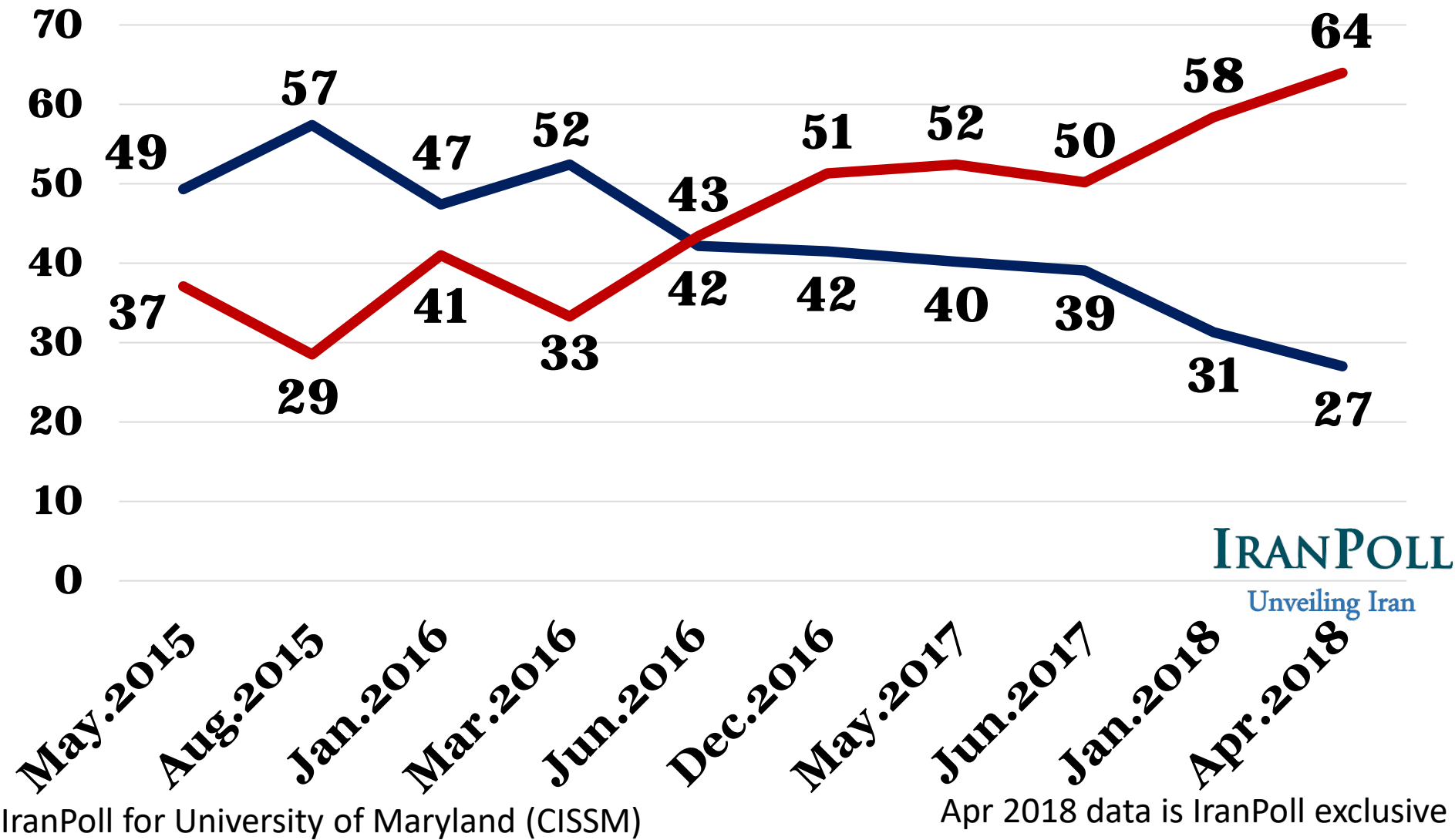
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Right now, do you think economic conditions in Iran, as a whole, are getting better or getting worse?

—Getting better

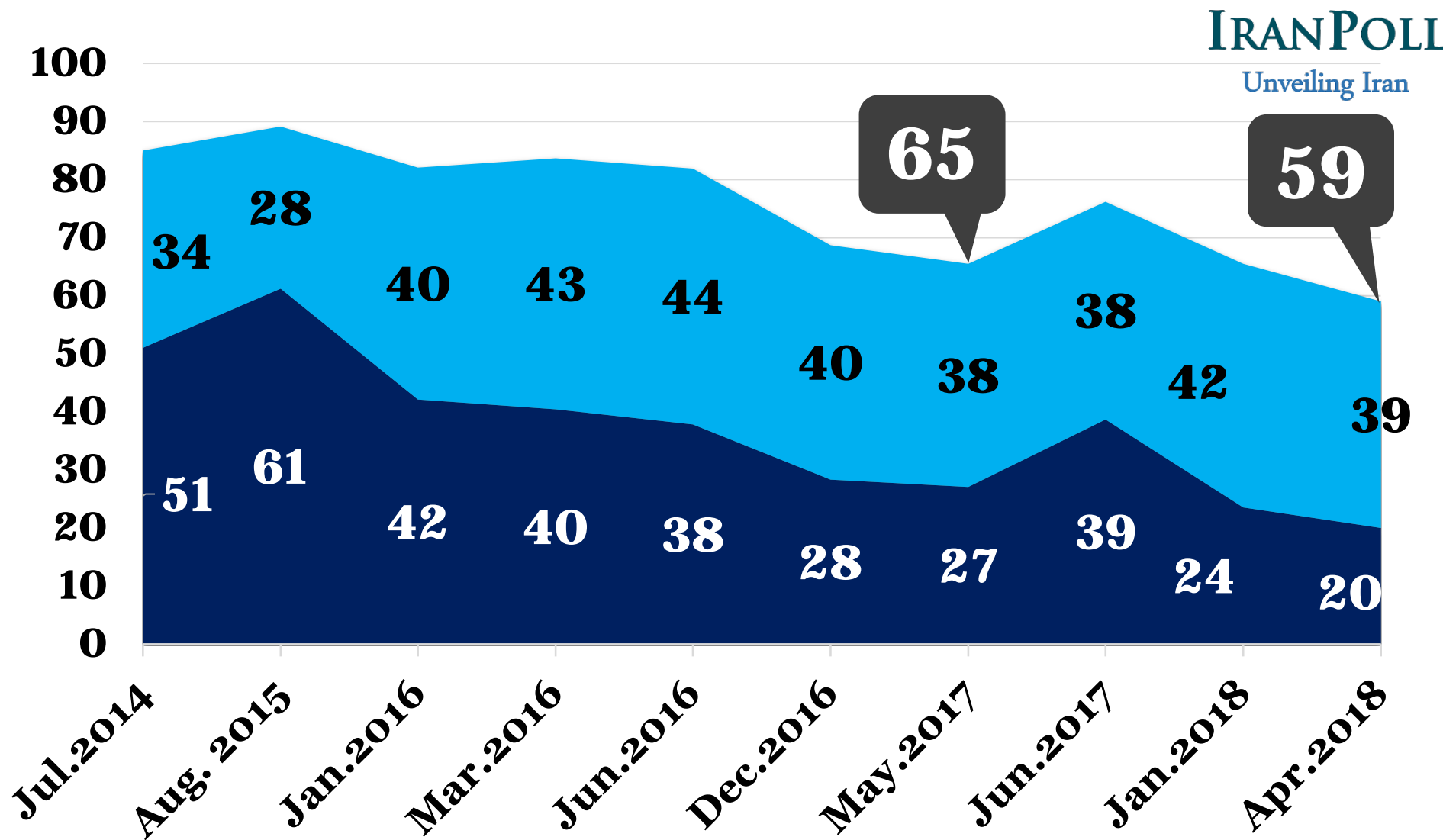
—Getting worse

■ Very favorable ■ Somewhat favorable



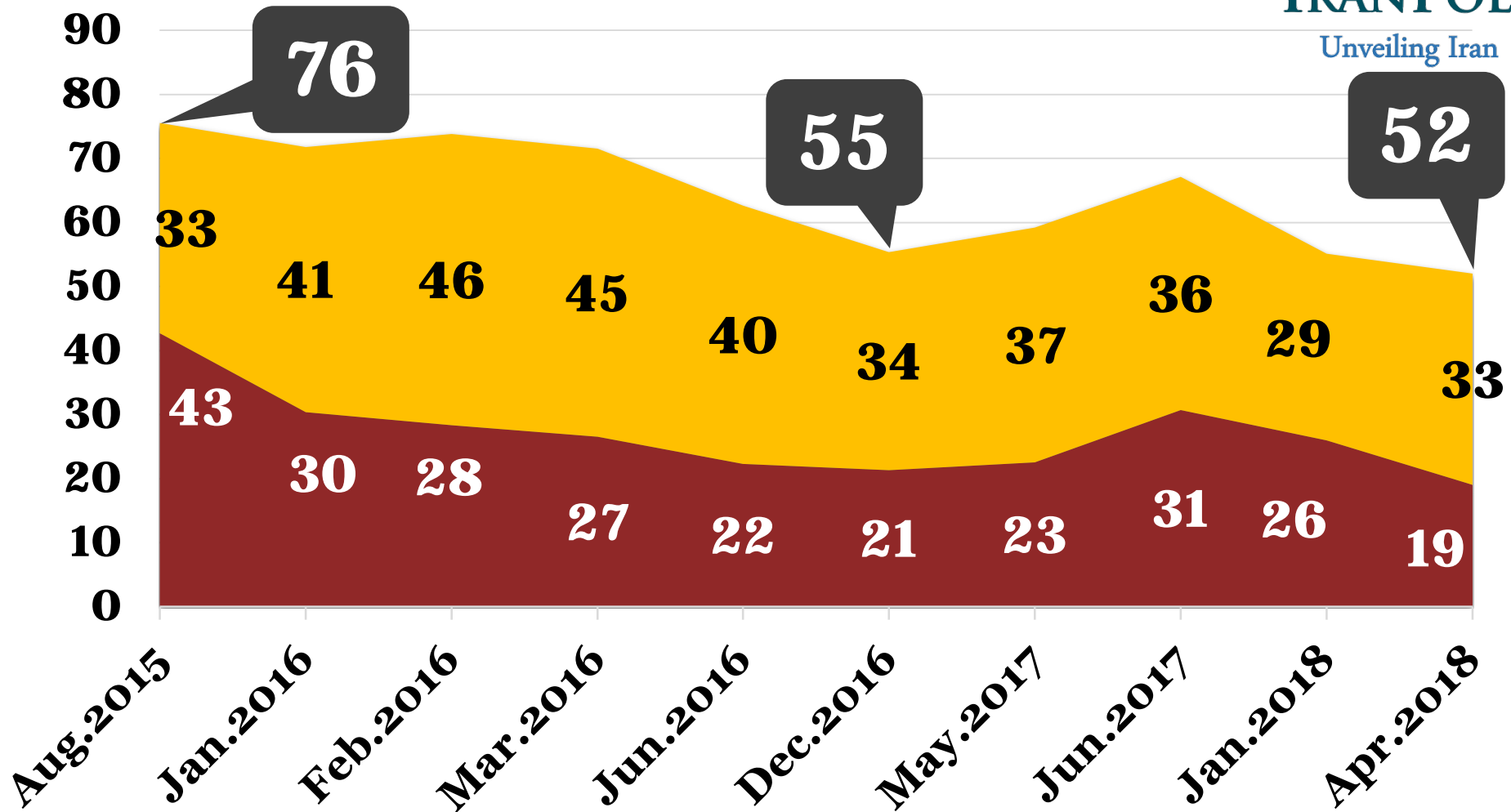
To what degree do you approve or disapprove of the JCPOA agreement?

■ Somewhat approve

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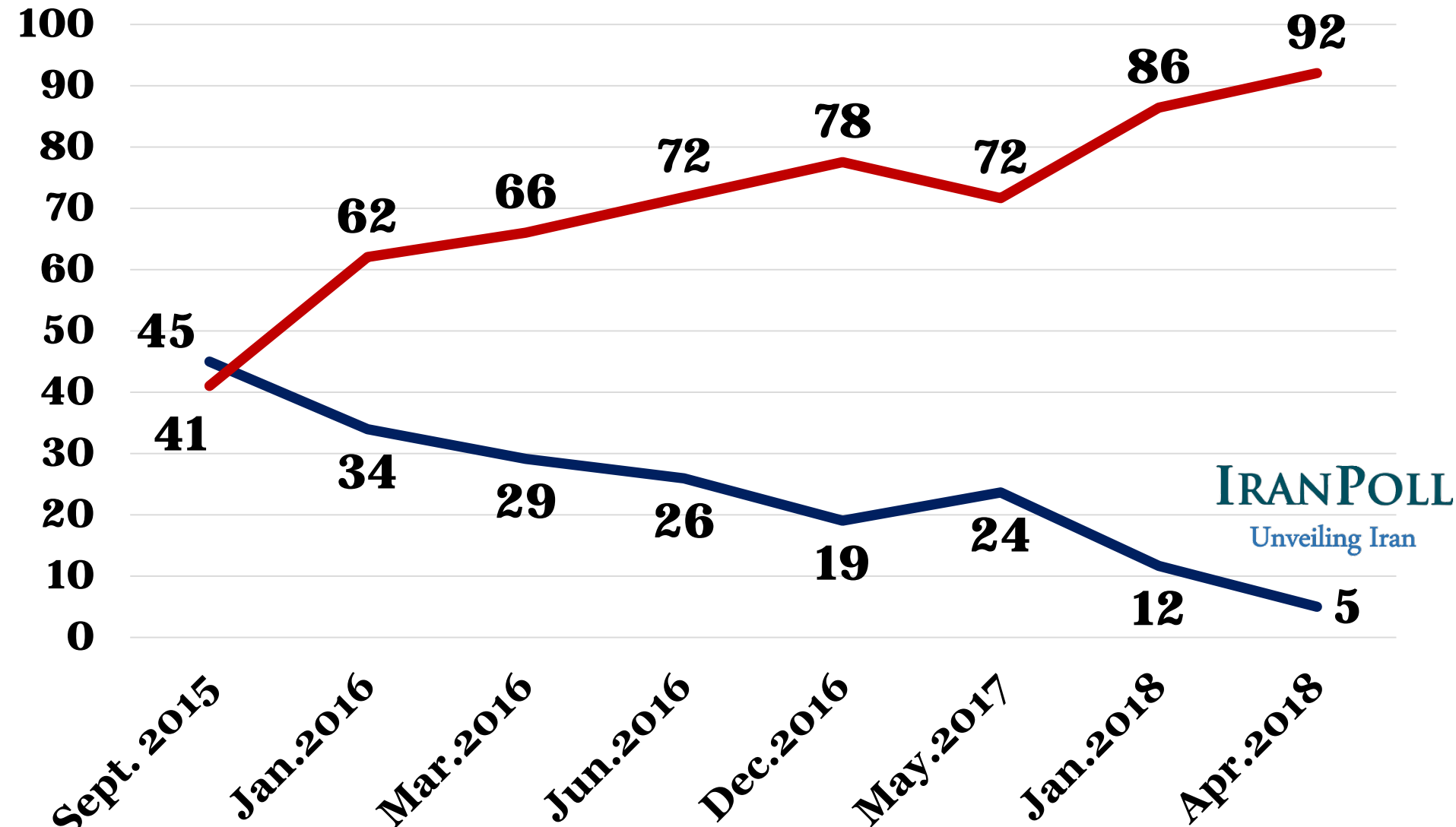


Iranians' confidence

—Not confident

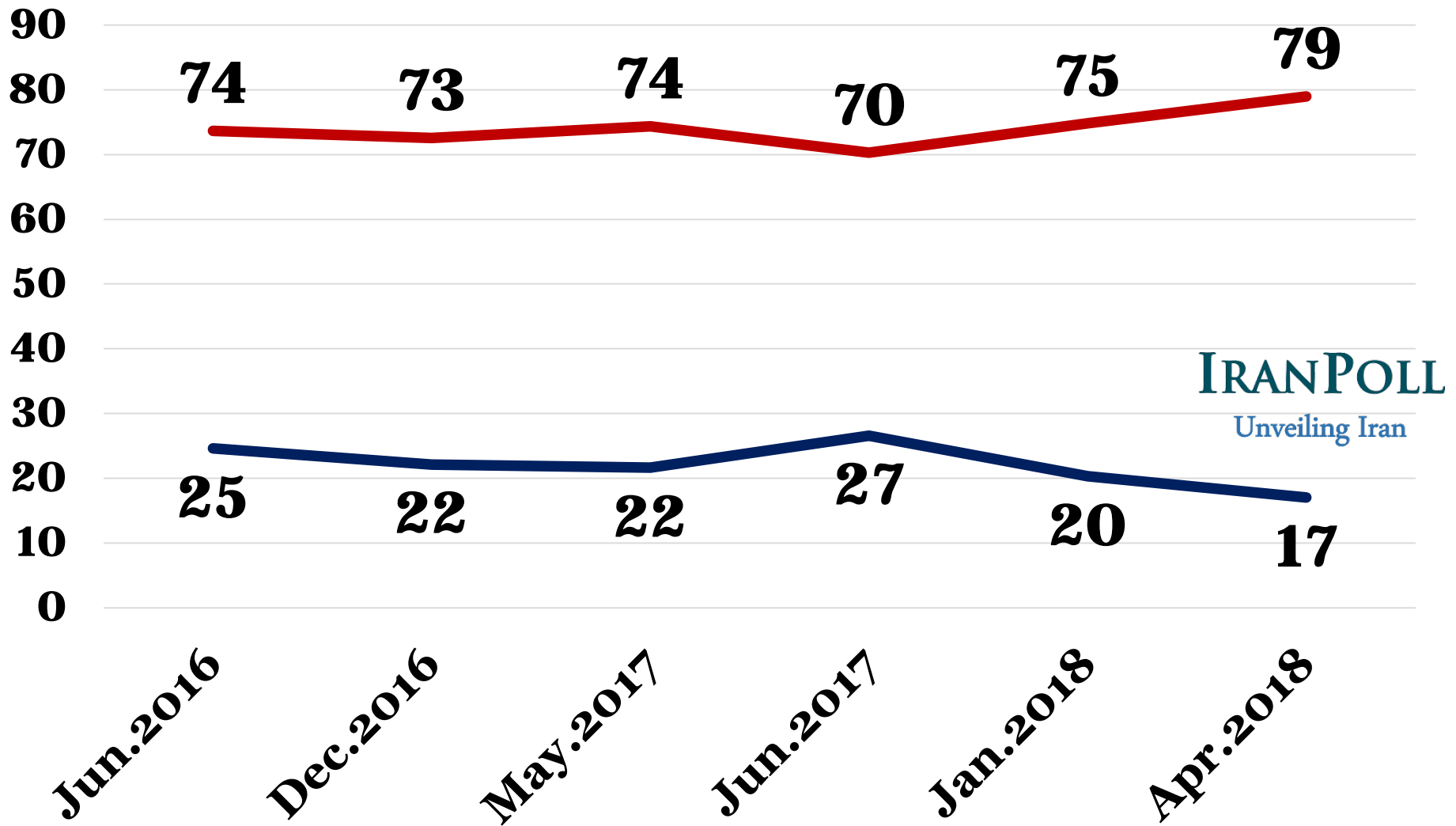


And they blame US

—Have Improved

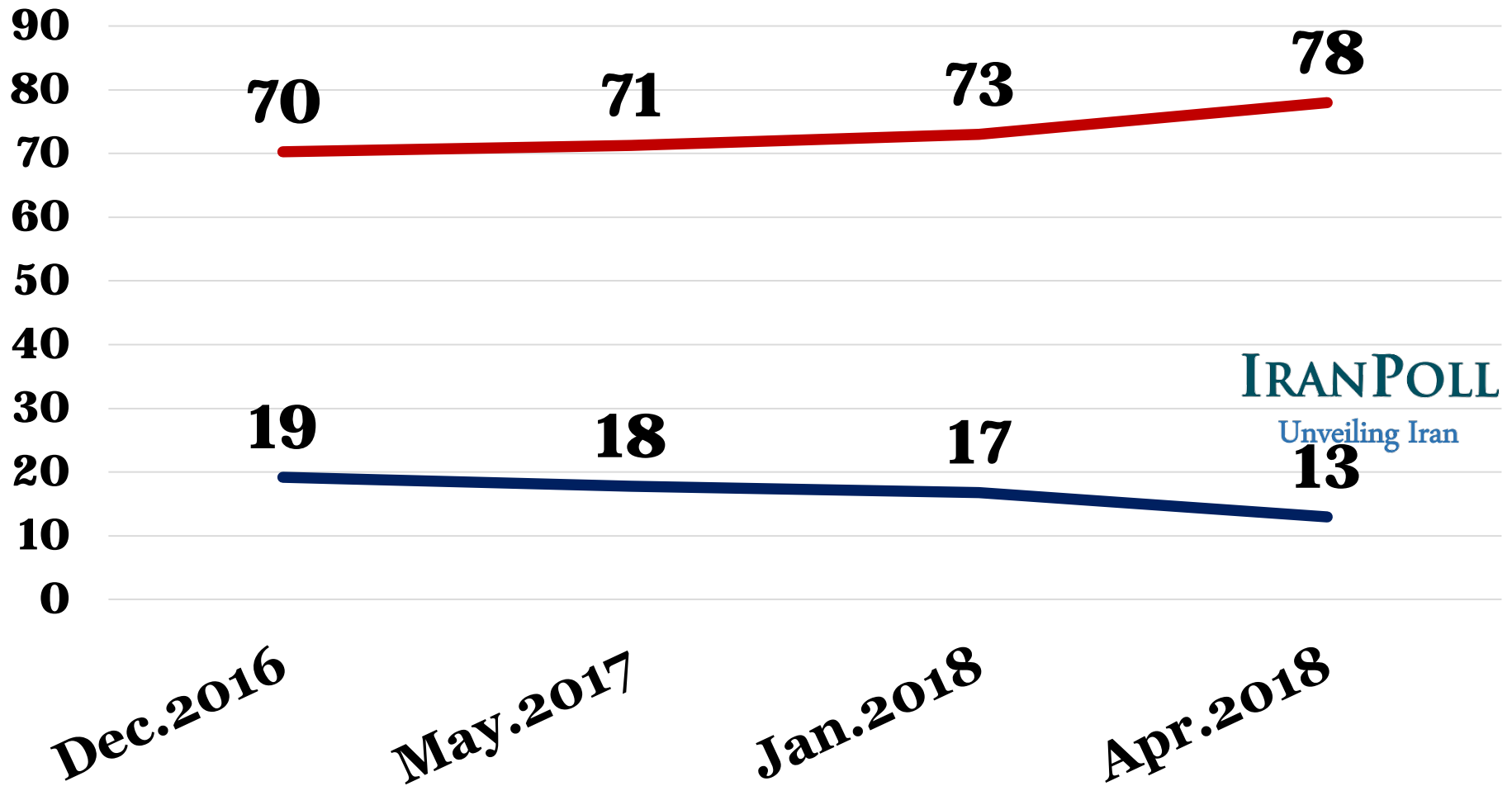
—Have not improved



Are European countries moving as rapidly as they can to trade and invest with Iran now that some sanctions have been lifted, or are they moving slower than they could?

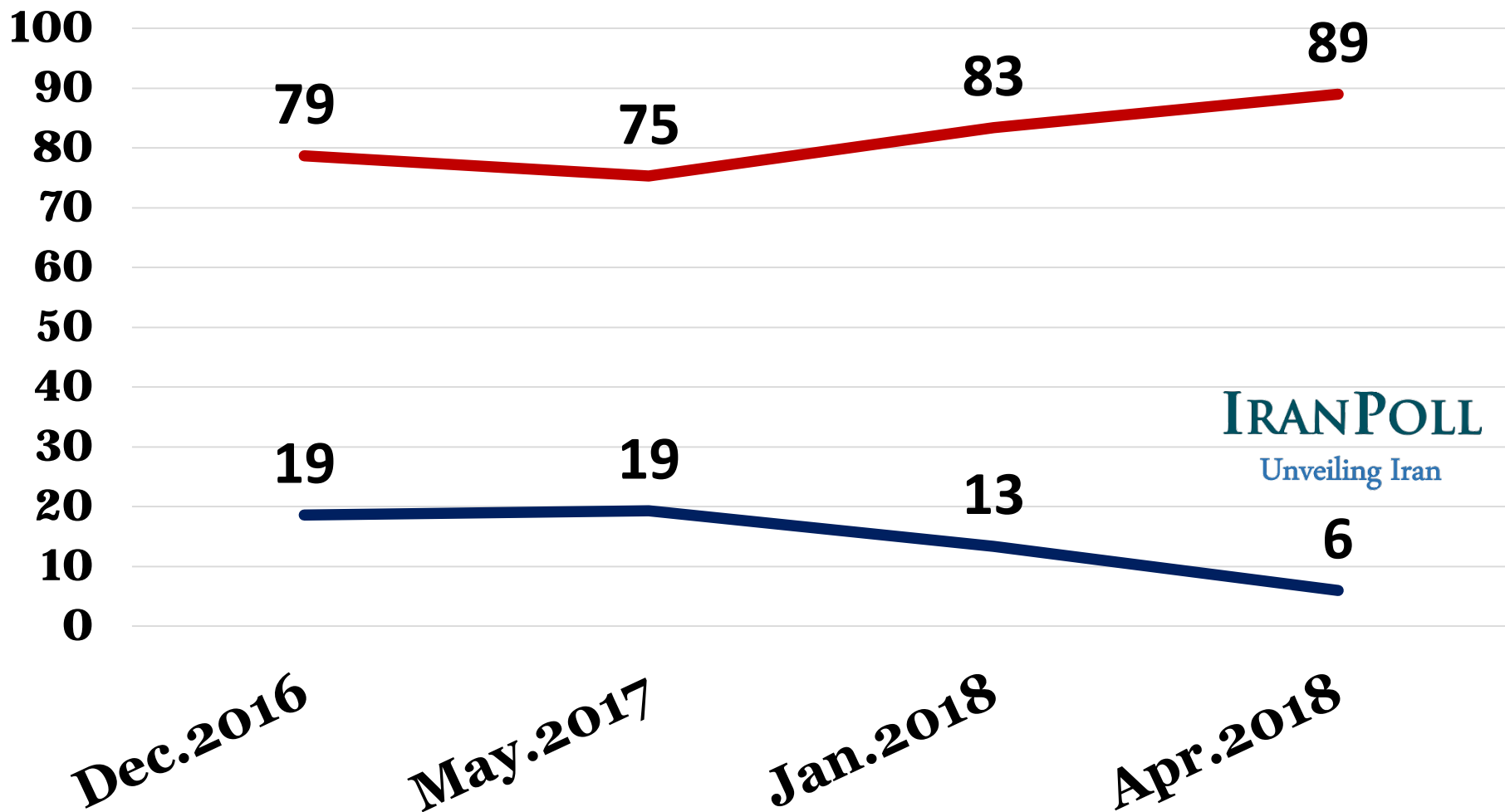
—Moving rapidly

In your opinion, are European countries moving slower than they could to trade and invest with Iran mostly because of:

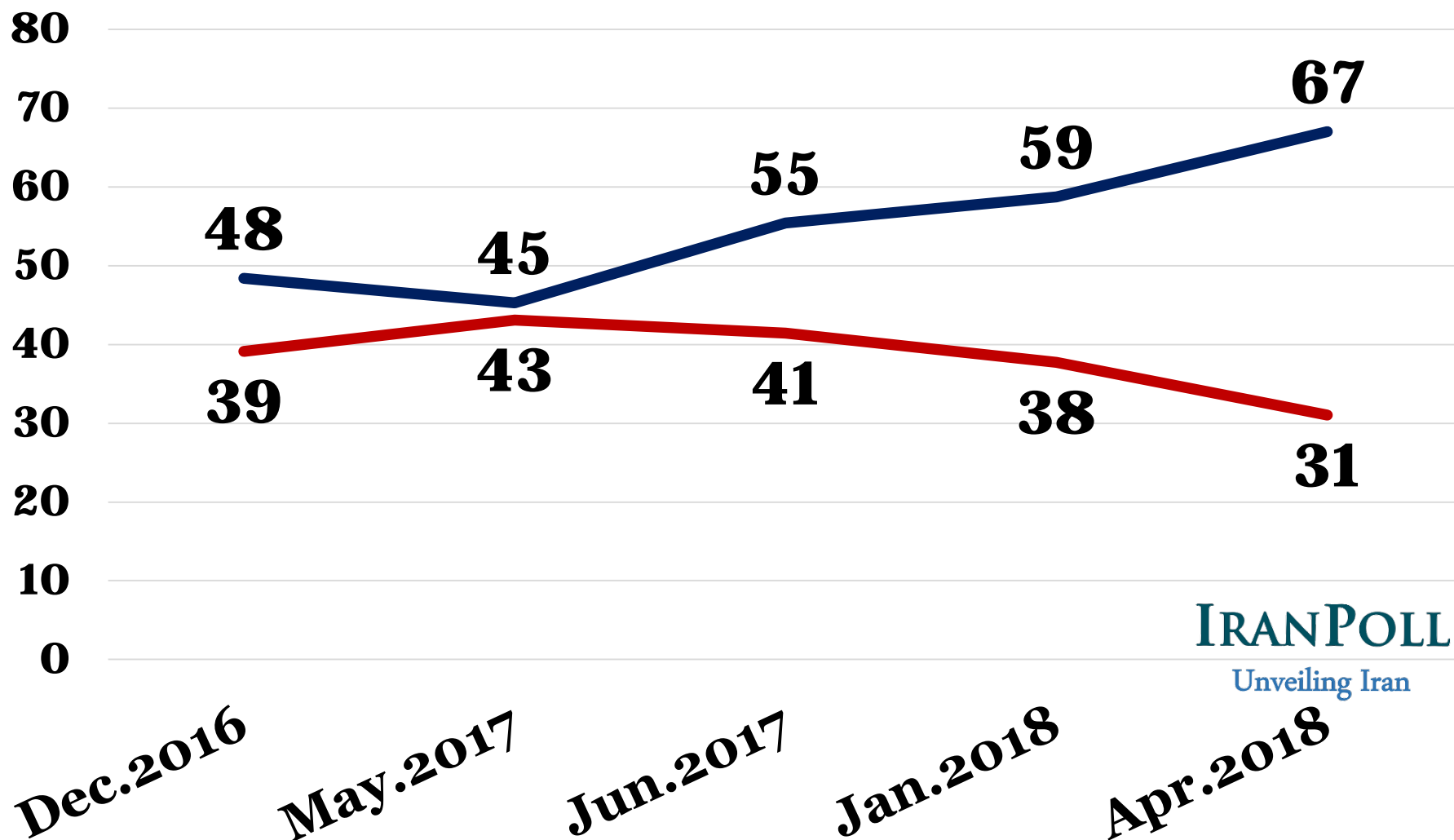
— Iran's own weaknesses — Pressure or fear of the US

— Iran should retaliate — Iran should continue to live by the JCPOA



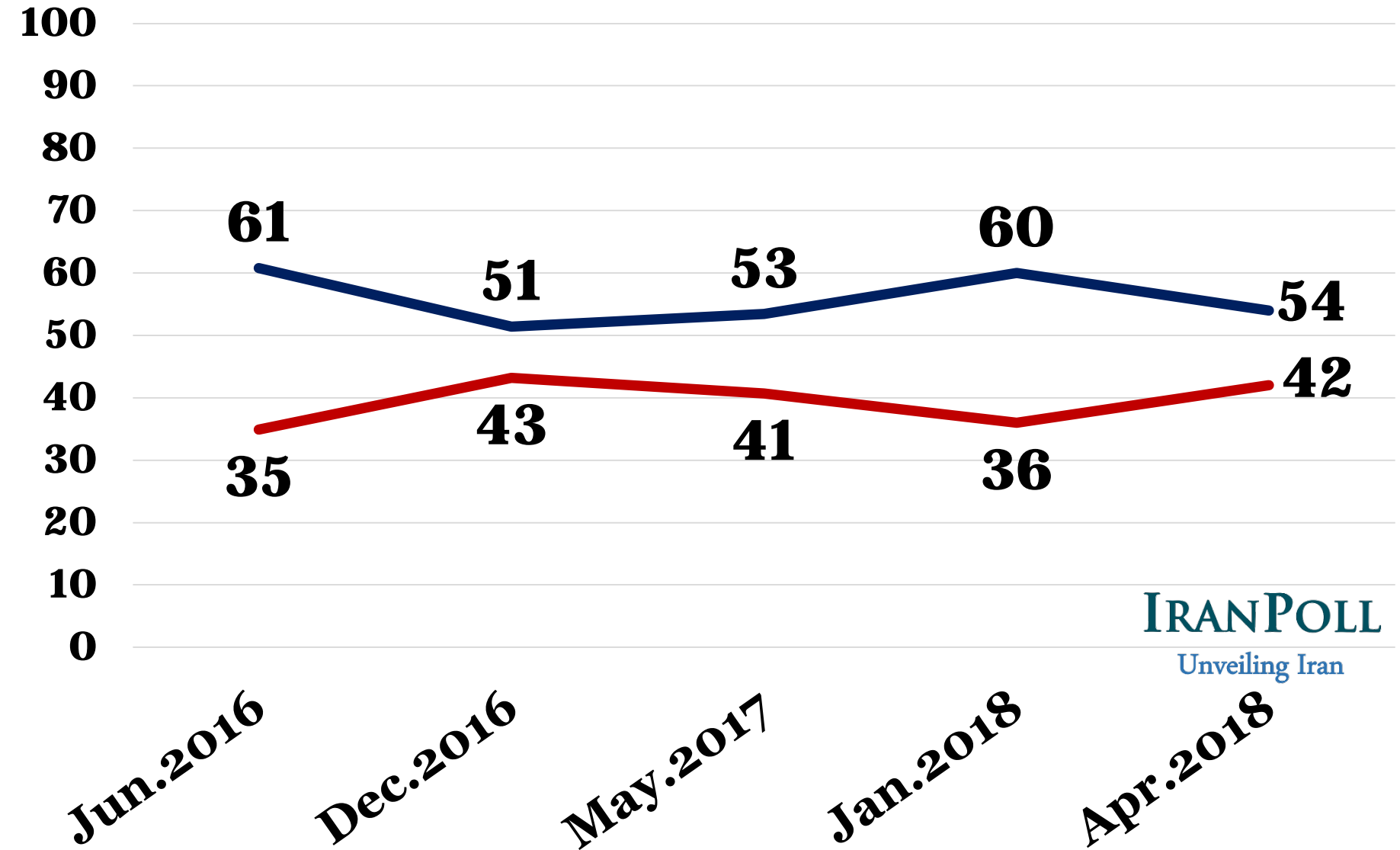
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Iranians are becoming

—Not confident

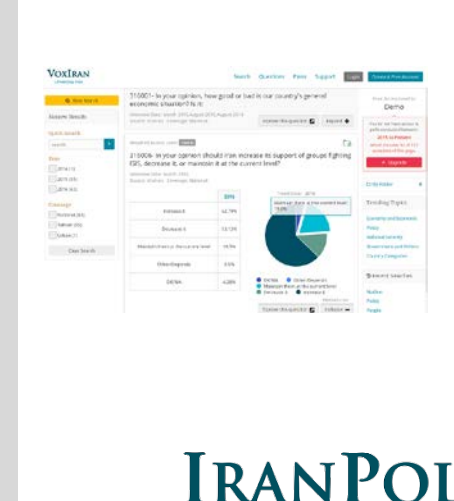
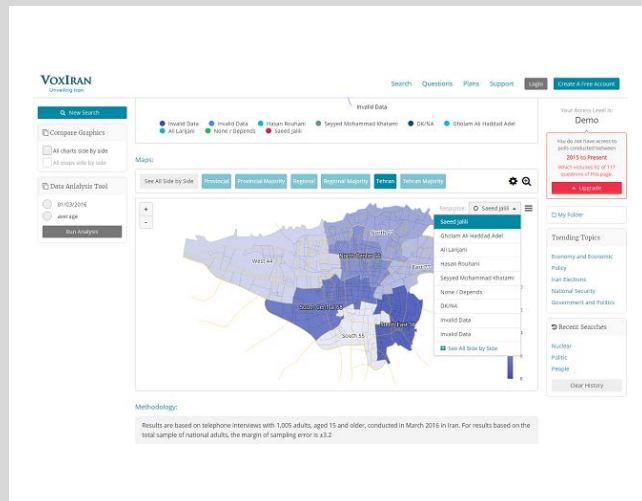
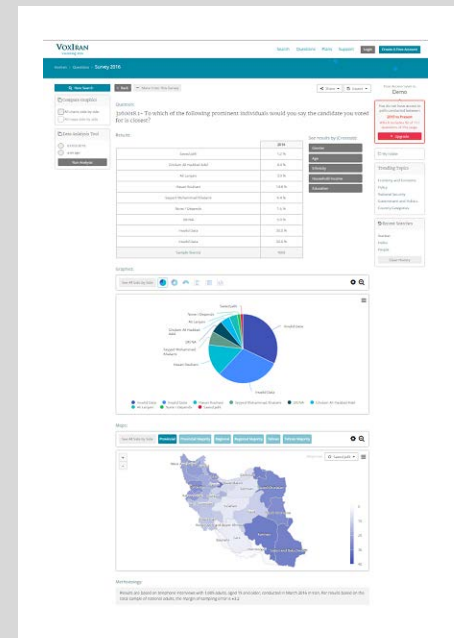
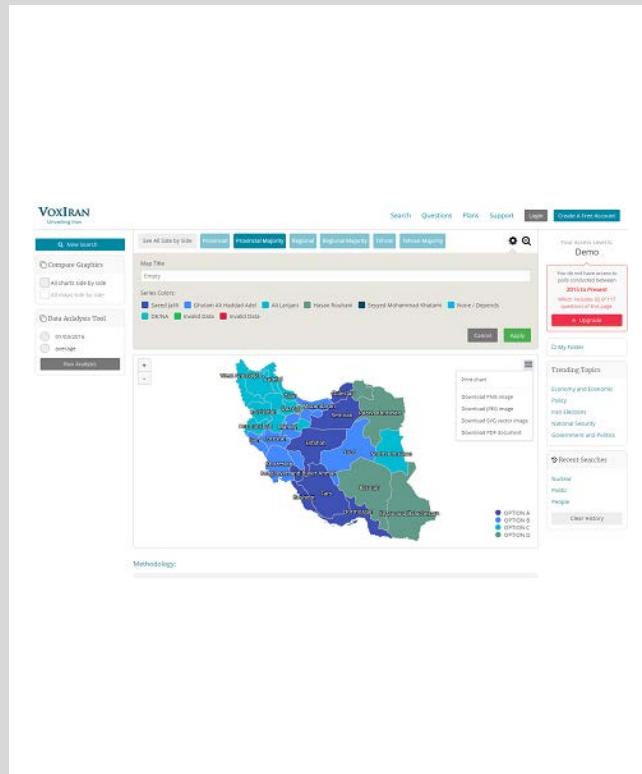


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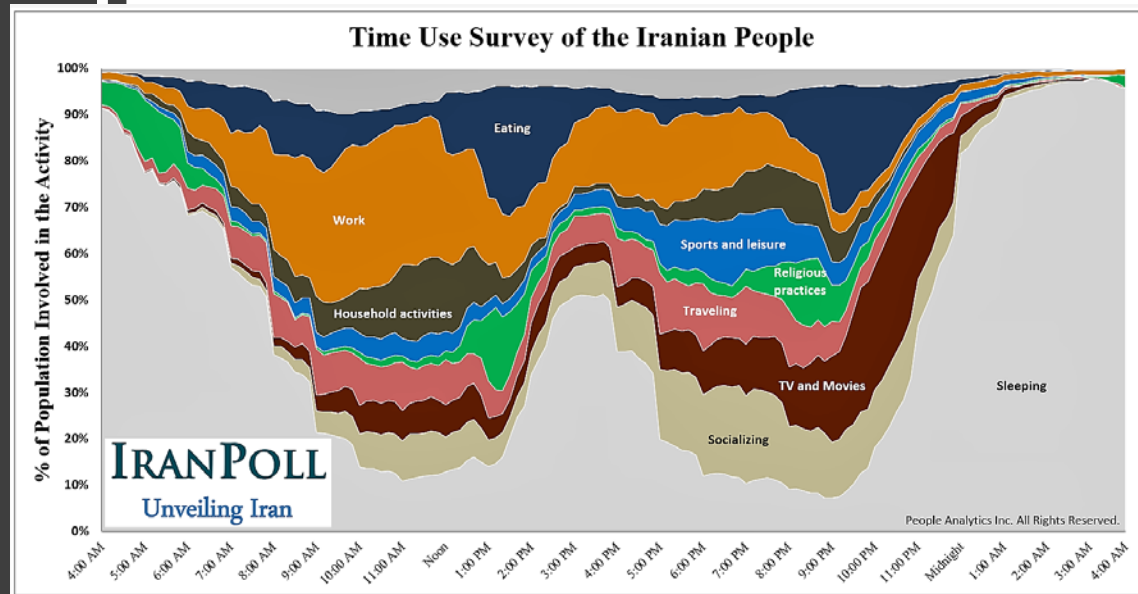
