New Concrete Did you notice the new concrete pad in the west parking lot by the canopy? Over the years, the heavy trash service truck has aggravated the asphalt, so a \$4,000 concrete pad was installed this week.

Building News Before progress can be made on any new building additions the AT&T underground fiber-optics must be relocated at the estimated cost of \$52,000 paid by ET. This week a check was sent to AT&T for \$47,121.55! We are now on schedule for August 2015 relocation. Pray that the cost continues to go down.
