The goal of the **Community Bulletin Board** is to inform the church fellowship of events, needs, goods and services.

The Community Bulletin Board is located at the top of the WEST stairs in the main church building.

Postings should be brief and to the point.

Bulletin board items will be posted for four weeks. Business cards may also be posted on the community bulletin board and may remain there indefinitely.

All postings must be approved by the church office. The office will date all items posted, with the exception of business cards. After the four week time frame, the item will be removed in order to accommodate other postings.

Bulletin board postings should be limited to signs no larger than 8½ x 11 inches.

EVENT BULLETIN BOARD GUIDELINES

The goal of the **Event Bulletin Board** is to inform the church fellowship of events at the church or sponsored by the church.

Event Bulletin Boards are located on the second floor, by the elevator, on the WEST stair landing between the first and second floors and in the restrooms. Items should **Only** be placed on the designated bulletin boards. Please do not post items on the doors or walls.

Postings should be brief and to the point.

Bulletin board items will remain on the Event Bulletin Boards until the event has passed.

All postings must be approved by the church office.

After the event has happened, the posted item should be removed by the person(s) responsible for the posting, in order to accommodate other postings.

Bulletin board postings should be limited to signs no larger than 8½ x 11 inches.
