Drs. Jey & Lizy Jeyaseelan recently celebrated 50 years of ministry. Dr. Jey came to know the Lord as a teenager in 1963 and was immediately a changed man, giving over his whole life to serving God.

Since then Drs. Jey & Lizy's ministry has spread to fifteen states in India and includes many different ministries such as Slum Schools, Feeding Programs, Sewing Schools, Bible Colleges and even a Health Care ministry in the slums of India.

In 50 years of ministry, Dr. Jey has accomplished great things for the kingdom of God in the nation of India and his vision has never stopped expanding! Dr. Jey has a vision to plant a Victory Church in every district of India – that is 626 churches – by 2020.

Dr. Jey wants to be able to reach 30,000 children in the slums and villages with the love of God. They are now starting slum school projects in Calcutta, which has one of the worst and largest slums in the world and are pushing to establish a sewing school in each of India's twenty eight states. All things are possible to him that believes and they believe all these things and more can be accomplished through the grace of God!
