Since I arrived early, he took me on a quick tour of the church, and the surrounding area. After telling of the incredible ways God had blessed it, he excitedly told me the most amazing thing: "In this village we haven't been persecuted!" God knew what He was doing, though. We have now been studying a language whose native people are less than 1% reached. This region, in fact, is home to the 7th most unreached people groups of 36 in this whole nation. Pray With Us—For protection!, for wisdom so we know how to be safe without sacrificing effective outreach. Praise God for His protection so far!
