Advent theme | Luke 1:34-37 | This past summer, a man from Florida named Kevin Chandler was overcome with the desire to tour Europe. Many of us desire to travel, to see new things, to experience life in a different way. There was one major challenge facing Kevin. Due to spinal muscular atrophy, Kevin's arms and legs are crippled and paralyzed. It's impossible to travel to another country without the use of your arms and legs! Well, it is possible with help. Kevin's friends decided they would help him achieve his dream. They spent 10 days in Europe, each taking turns carrying a special backpack on their back, taking in all of the sights. Kevin could have known the joy of travel without the help of his friends. Sometime joy can be a received gift, not a manufactured feeling. When Mary first received the news that she would be the mother of Jesus, her heart was full of questions. She asked the angel, "How can this happen?" (Luke 1:34) The Angel told her, "Don't worry, you're going to have help! Holy Spirit will be with you, and you won't have to do this in your own strength." (Luke 1:35) When she humbly received help, she was able to say with full confidence, "I am the Lord's servant." (Luke 1:38) If joy feels impossible for you this Christmas season, you must reach out to the God who makes all things possible. Joy can be found in surrender, when we say, "I simply cannot do it all on my own strength." As a family, ask each other what struggles each person might be facing right now. Take time to pray, to ask God for help, to receive His blessing of joy this season.
