Goals:

- 👑 Designed to sustain relationships with children of abuse who have attended our annual RFK Camps
- 👑 Provide life-changing moments for children of abuse
- 👑 Build on TRUST established at camp

Mentoring CLUBS

C is for **COMMITMENT**: A foster child knows one thing about you: When you walk into his or her life, you will leave sooner or later! The commitment between Mentor and Mentoring Club kids is strengthened by community and Ceremony.

L is for **LEADERSHIP**: Teaching Leadership, Character, and Values. Providing Role Models who take responsibility through Bible Stories, historical heroes, and Mentors. Providing ways for Mentoring Club kids to take leadership and responsibility in the group.

U is for **UNDERSTANDING**: Volunteers who "get" where foster kids are coming from – child training and camp experience working together as a team to create understanding.

B is for **BELONGING**: "You're in the Club!" Club kids often feel like outsiders, even in their own homes.

S is for **SAFE PLACE**: Adults keep rules and don't permit abuse or bullying of Club Kids. They foster Care and Friendship with the kids.

Activities: Games, table activities, field trips, snacks, key Bible verses each month with Bible stories
