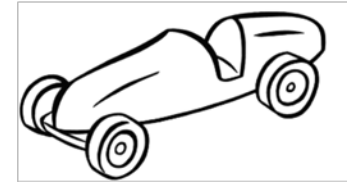
LIGHT FOR THE LOST BANQUET
