## English as Second Language (ESL)

We offer 11 different programs spread over four levels of English language fluency. In the first three levels there are six ESL programs, which are 24 weeks in length. They are ESL Beginning (IA, IB, IIA, IIB), ESL Intermediate (IA, 1B, IIA, IIB), and ESL Advanced (IA, 1B, IIA, IIB). In the fourth level we offer four programs of 12 weeks each: TOEFL I, II, III, and IV. To ensure and reinforce proper learning, all students in ESL classes are administered quizzes, mid-terms, and finals.

## TOEFL

In the IBT TOEFL preparation course, students will review and expand high intermediate to advanced speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills. The students begin by taking a diagnostic exam to identify their weak areas. Then they receive a complete overview of test taking strategies for the IBT TOEFL test, including vocabulary development, strategies for reading comprehension, identification of listening topics, speech cohesion and pronunciation, and fundamentals of essay writing.
