The council has approved some necessary work for the church property. The roofing on the flat part will be removed and replaced at a cost of \$4,425. The sign along the street is rotted out after 25 years, and will be replaced with a similar back lit sign at a cost of \$7,000. A full color message sign like many churches have would cost \$18,000. The parking lot lights will be replaced with LED lights at a cost of \$2,000. There may be a rebate from Consumers Energy for going to LED. These improvements collectively will cost \$13,425.00, which is under the \$15,000 requiring congregational approval. The building committee has also been gathering quotes for the parking lot, possibly for next year.
