Requirements:

- U.S. Citizen
- Senior High School Student (graduating from a accredited high school)
- Accepted and enrolled in an accredited trade school, college, or university
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Mission statement on the reason for choosing your career/educational path (50 words or more)
- The San Rocco Festa means many things to many people, in 200 words or less write a paragraph explaining, 'What the San Rocco Festa means or has meant to me'. Please avoid the use of identifiable names.

All eligible applicants must submit a 400 word essay choosing from the following topics:

- What family means to me
- Why tradition and cultural heritage is important
- How volunteer work has affected my life

Additionally, eligible applicants must provide a list of all school activities as well as community service projects they are (or have been) involved in.

Disclaimers:

- 1) Eligibility: Members of the board of the San Rocco Foundation, their children, and grandchildren are ineligible.
- 2) Winner must show proof of registration to the school of their choice.
- 3) The payment will be sent directly to the school upon confirmation of enrollment.
