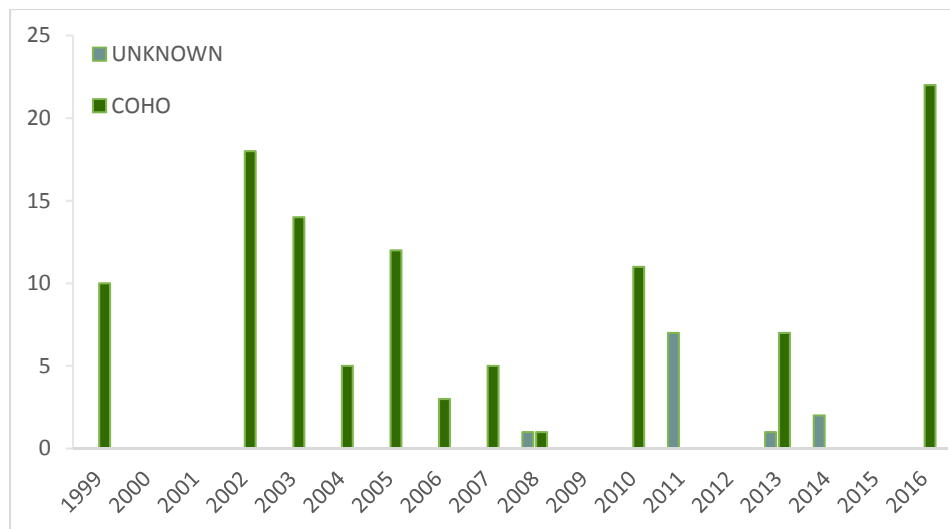


TINLING CREEK



Tinling Creek lies in the South Fork Nooksack watershed. In 2010 a culvert was replaced with a bridge to allow fish passage upstream. Large woody debris placements, channel modification, and riparian planting occurred through 2012 to help the creek find its channel after a debris flow brought excess sediment and gravel to the area in 2009.
