## 2019-2020 Half Year Report

Master Recycler Program

City of Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability

July - December 2019



### Program Description

The Master Recycler Program is a community education and outreach program on sustainable consumption and recycling. The program offers three trainings a year, rotating counties throughout the Portland metro region. Participants gain knowledge on waste reduction and skill in outreach techniques. In return, graduates commit to at least thirty hours of community engagement. The course costs \$50. Scholarships are available. Master Recyclers volunteer at local events and through individual projects. Master Recyclers also receive ongoing training and support that includes a monthly newsletter, a website, quarterly open houses, volunteer opportunities, Master Recycler Mentors and assistance on individual projects.

### Community-Designed Course

No community-designed courses took place in the first half of this fiscal year; however, several are in the works:

- One is planned for January- February with N by NE Community Health Center, a health clinic focused on African-American health on NE Alberta in Portland.
- The second Spanish Language course is planned in the spring with Centro Cultural and Washington County.
- Clackamas County Staff have had a brainstorm session to identify communities who might like to partner in fiscal year 2020-2021.

Participation in volunteer activities for the Trash for Peace and Centro Cultural/Washington county courses have gotten off to a great start. Both have reached new communities and organized new projects such as a sharing closet in the Rockwood housing complex and a toxics collection event at Centro Cultural. Trash for Peace members have accumulated 200 hours so far and Centro Cultural Washington County members have accumulated 434 hours, with one member already reaching Centurion status by reporting 100 hours!



## Annual County Course Updates

### Class 74 // Fall 2019 // Washington County



- *Location:* Juanita Pohl Center Tualatin. This was the first time offering the course in Tualatin.
- *Applications:*
  - 70 people applied.
  - 29 people completed the course.
  - Two people had to drop the class.
- *Scholarships:* These scholarships increase access to the program for residents of each of their jurisdictions
  - Six scholarships were granted.
  - Washington County paid for 5 scholarships
  - The City of Beaverton paid for one scholarship.
- *Diversity Goals:*
  - 31 people filled out the demographics survey.
  - This was the highest income class in the history of the survey with 48% reporting more than \$100,000 income and only 9% reporting less than \$25,000
  - 27% are renters.
  - 18% live in multifamily communities.
  - 16% of respondents self-identified as a person of color: four Asian, one Hispanic/Latino, one Black. (People can check multiple options)
  - Other than English, the following languages are spoken in the home of respondents: Spanish and Japanese.
  - Two people identified as a person with a disability.
- *Geographical participation is as follows:*
  - 4 Beaverton
  - 1 Cornelius
  - 1 Hillsboro

- 10 unincorporated Washington County
- 4 Tigard
- 6 Tualatin

243 hours are reported so far with from 29 graduates, three people have certified.

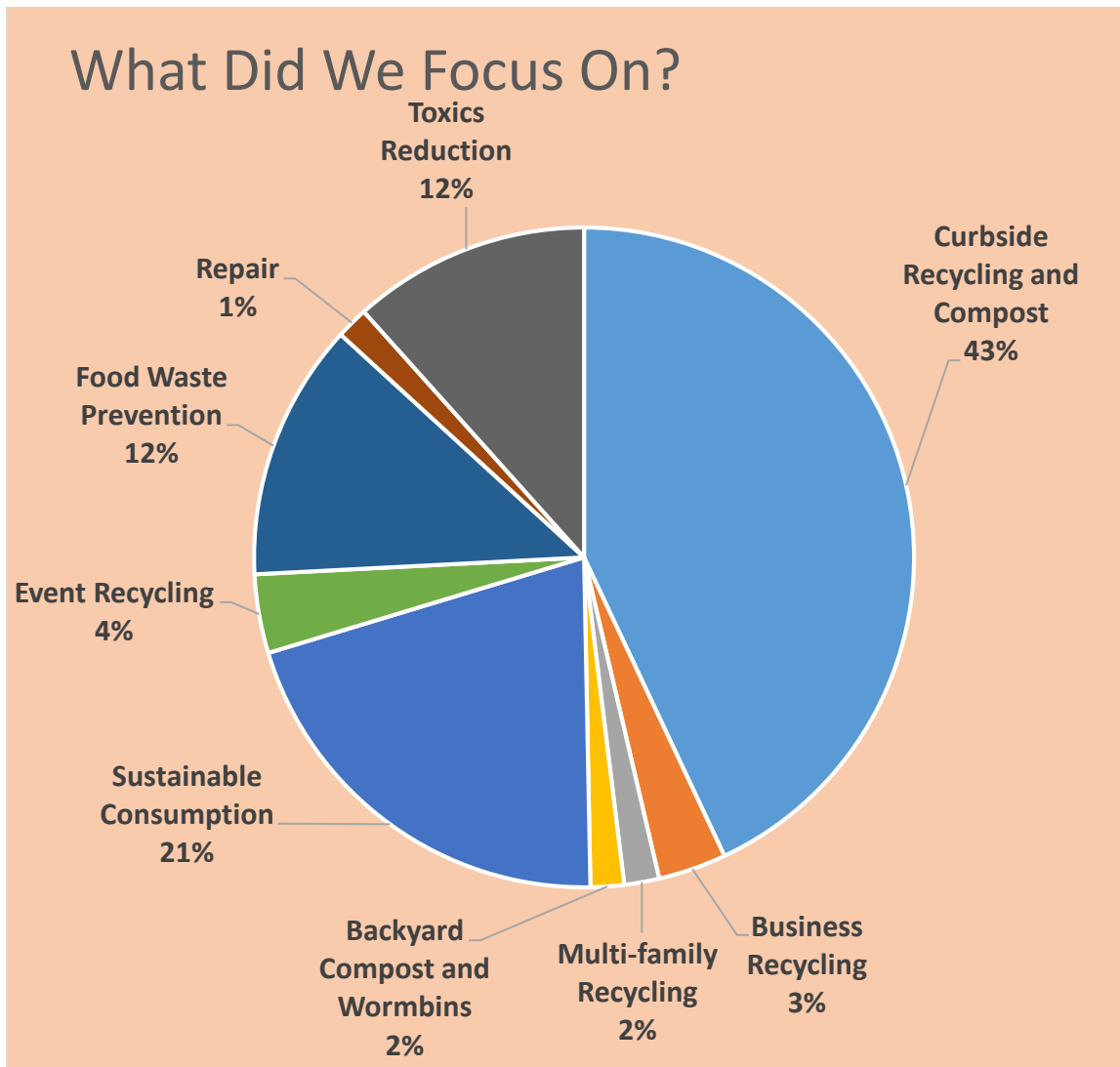

**First Half of Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Volunteer Hours and Contacts**

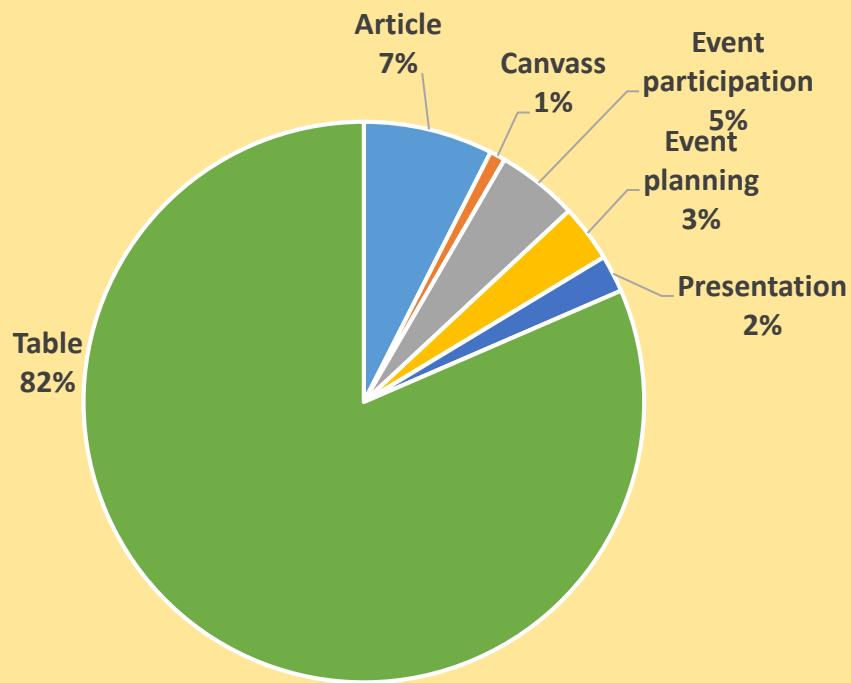

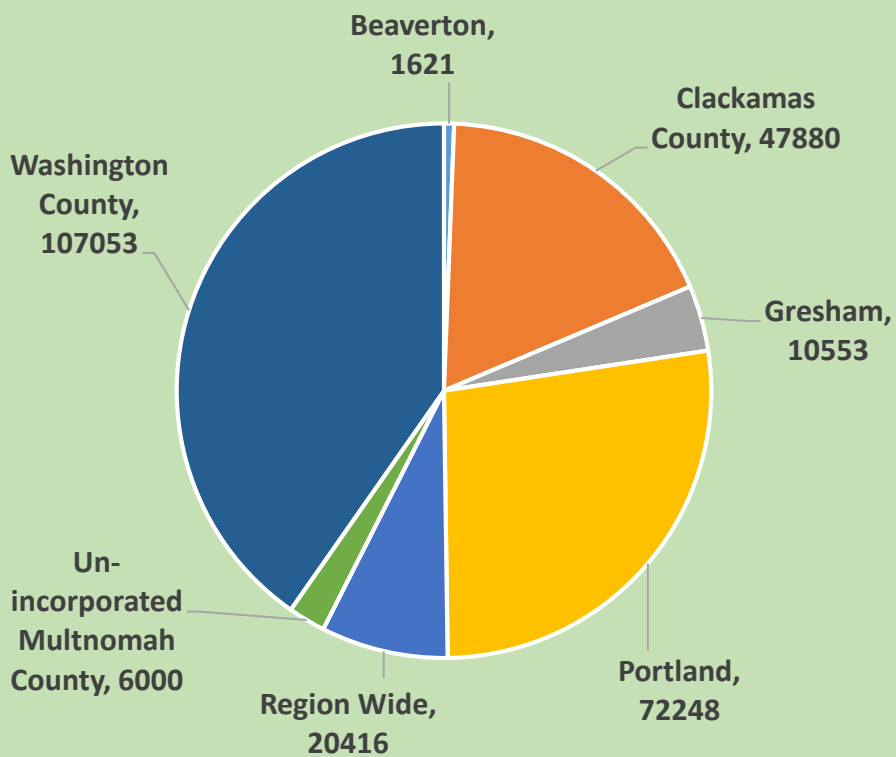
