## Shoebox Guidelines

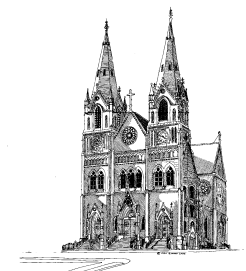
