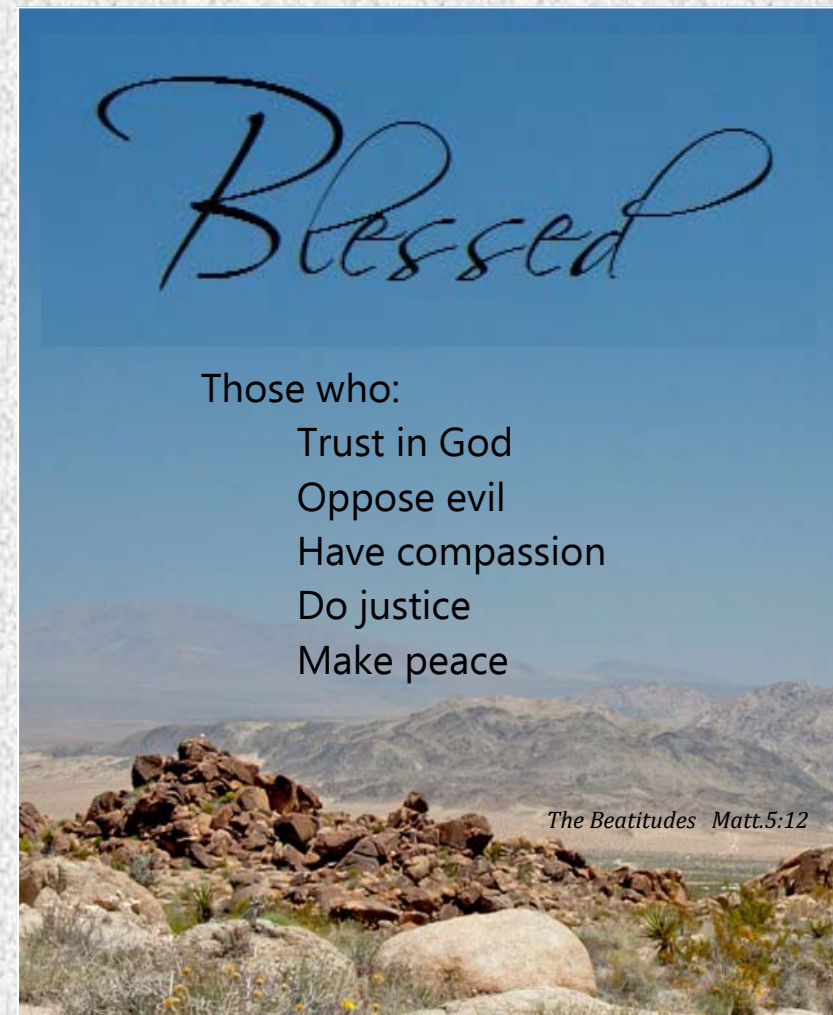
We are saddened to share that mother's of two parishioners have passed this week.

February is Black History Month

is set aside to learn, honor, and celebrate the achievements of black men and women throughout history. The origins of Black History Month can be traced back to a man named Carter G. Woodson (1875-1950). Self-taught at an early age, he eventually became the second African American to earn a doctorate from Harvard University. In 1915, Woodson participated in a celebration of the 50th anniversary of the end of slavery. The trip had a

great impact on him and inspired him to continue the study of black history. Woodson realized that most textbooks at the time ignored the history and achievements of blacks. Thus he wanted to find a way to encourage interest and study of black history. In 1926, Woodson promoted the idea of a "Negro History Week," which was to be held during the second week of February. The idea caught on quickly and Negro History Week was soon celebrated around the United States.
