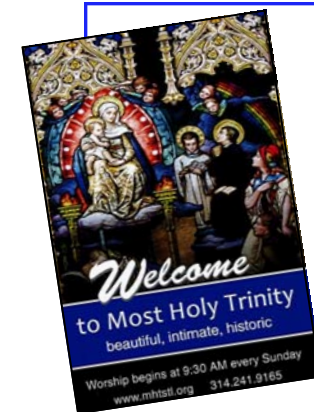

Congratulations Father Rich!

Father Rich was ordained in 1967 as the Church was going through an inspired awakening as the result of Vatican II. The Council gave us a renewed understanding of "paschal mystery." How many times have we heard Fr. Rich use those words? The document stated that *by Baptism men and women are implanted in the paschal mystery of Christ; they die with him, are buried with him and rise with him.* (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy 6) Fr. Rich readily picked up on the centrality of the paschal mystery, made it a part of his life and then it became the blessing of light on all of us. Knowing that our faith hinges on the death and resurrection of Christ we have, as a faith community, come to say, "I believe." Thank you Fr. Rich for that insight! Thank you for your years of leadership, friendship and example that has warmed our hearts like a great peat fire.

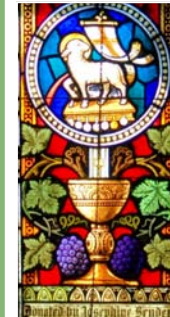
