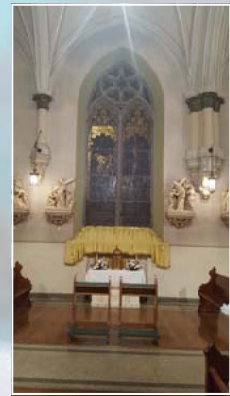

 The season of Lent is rich in beautiful choral music. St. Louis Chamber Chorus artistic director Philip Barnes knows the a cappella repertoire better than almost anyone, giving him a distinct advantage in a program for a Palm Sunday afternoon. Barnes chose a fine selection of minor-key pieces for Sunday's concert at the acoustically splendid and architecturally notable Most Holy Trinity Roman Catholic Church, in the Hyde Park neighborhood. The music ranged from the Renaissance to the contemporary. Barnes sometimes builds programs around a Mass setting. This time, the connectors were Francis Poulenc's "Quatre Motets pour un temps de pénitence," settings of psalms and Holy Week responses. Fruits of Poulenc's 1936 return to faith, they speak in the composer's unique musical voice, their expressive angularities communicating in a fashion.
