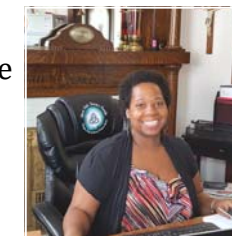

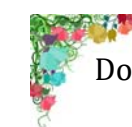
Annual Catholic Appeal
