Wednesday, May 31 – Topic: Pentecost.

Pentecost happens when we soothe the tensions of disagreement among family, friends, and nations; when we choose reconciliation over retaliation; when we breathe new life into hearts deadened by greed, selfishness, apathy. *How do you witness the presence of the Spirit in your life or in the life of another?*

Tuesday, June 6 – Topic: Holy Trinity

One of the greatest gifts of Christianity is the dogma of the triune God. How amazing and wonderfully mysterious at the same time! *How can the life of a Christian and my life be a reflection and a participation in the life of the Trinity?*

Tuesday June 13 – Topic: Corpus Christi

Corpus Christi is the most Catholic of days, an expression of our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. And yet, this celebration is also outward looking, carrying the liturgy out of the church and into the streets. *We celebrate the mystery of Christ's abiding presence in the Church.
