Can you feel the invitation to complete this circle of love by sitting with them at the table?

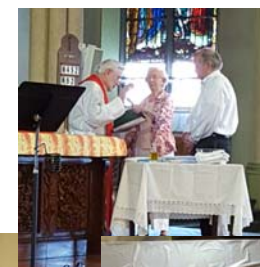
How does looking at this with your inner eyes help you understand that all activity in this world can bear fruit only when they take place within this divine circle?
