We celebrate the mystery of Christ's abiding presence in the Church.

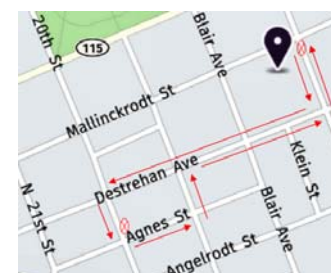
Are we prepared to receive this bread of everlasting life and how will we live what this presence demands of us?
