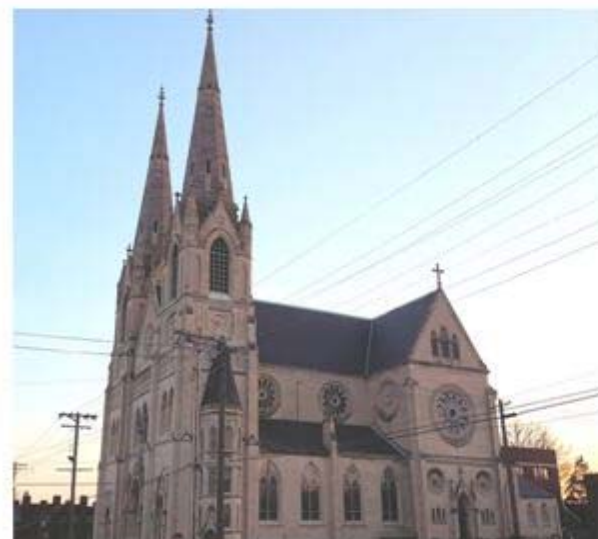


# Celebrating 169 Years

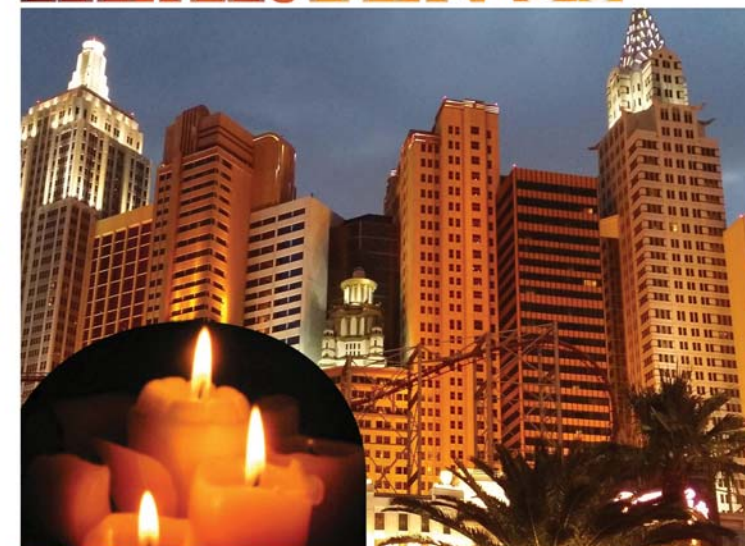

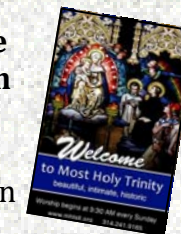
