Survey Results and Discussion: Looked at summary of the surveys from Town Meeting.

Notes from the NVDA Meeting on 3/18 on the ERAF (Emergency Relief Assistance Fund): Farley and Linda went to the meeting. Four mitigation measures must be in place by 10/23/14:

- Adopt road and bridge standards the “Orange Book”
- Adopt flood hazard regulations. Our regs are fine but may take some additional mapping. Farley will speak with Bob Alexander to get this started.
- Adopt local hazard mitigation plan. Needs to involve detailed information particular to Craftsbury and include input from Select Board, Road Commissioner, Fire Dept, Town Clerk, etc. Outreach to neighboring towns as well. NVDA is working on grants to help towns come into compliance with these new regulations. Linda will speak with Susie about this.
- Adopt Emergency Operation Plan. Needs to be updated every year.

Report on Visioning presentation by the Vermont Council on Rural Development at Select Board Meeting of April 15th. Paul Costello came and met with the Select Board and many other people in town. Many people felt quite positive about the meeting and it seemed unanimous to move ahead. The VCRD process takes about four months and is methodical, involving community meetings, surveys, and discussions.

Sung Hee reported that the Select Board reviewed the village designation map. There was a question about including Pete Johnson’s new facility in the officially designated ‘village map’. Sung Hee will contact Pete and clarify some of the details of opting in or out.
