The Selectboard met at the Craftsbury Town Hall on Tuesday, May 1, 2018 at 7 PM. Selectboard present were Bruce Urie, Jim Jones and Susan Houston. Yvette Brown (Town Clerk), Michelle Warren (Selectboard clerk), Wayne Mutrux, Jennifer Harlow Jacobs and her husband, Matt Moody and his wife were also present.

Approve Minutes Last Meeting:

Jim made a motion to approval the April 17, 2018 minutes as printed, approved.

Matt Moody - Mountain Hill Road (Class 3 or Class 4)

Matt Moody and his wife had concerns if their driveway on Mountain Hill Road was considered a Class 3 or Class 4. The Selectboard reviewed and discussed maps of Mountain Hill Road with Wayne and the Moodys.

Jim made a motion that according to the Vermont State Highway table on their 2014 map, from Common Loop .25 down Mountain Hill Road is Class 3, remainder according to the map noted above, is Class 4.

Motion passed.

The Selectboard will be talking with Steve, Craftsbury's Road foreman, about building that section of the road up to class 3 standards.

Weight Permits:

The Selectboard signed a weight permit for Fred Vance.

Jennifer Harlow Jacobs running for Orleans County Sheriff-Introducing Herself

Jennifer explained that she has worked in the police force for over 20 years, currently in the special victim unit in Newport. She will be running against incumbent Kirk Martin in the primary in August. She plans to be a working, active sheriff, a person people can contact when help is needed. She would like to offer fraud presentations for the elderly, among other proactive presentations.

Committee Reports:

Susan Suggested to buy Adrien a gift, for being Craftsbury's Representative of the Lamoille Solid Waste Management for 20 years, Bruce and Jim agreed. Susan will look into.

Susan was able to order another radar sign, for \$2778, only about \$100 more than before, she will need to

send them testimonials and pictures though for the discounted rate.

Susan requested for the cross walks to get painted again, on behalf of the Road Safety Committee. The Selectboard will look into fog lines on the Common Hill.

Hosmer Ponds Watershed Initiative is considering a sign-in area at Little Hosmer. If they get enough signatures, possible to apply for grant so some one could be present there educating people about Milfoil.

The Craftsbury Forestry Committee will be having their Common Walk on May 15th at 6:30 PM, reviewing the health of the Common trees. The Selectboard will meet at the Common afterwards.

On April 30, 2018 the Selectboard met with the Craftsbury Broadband Committee and made a motion to choose Pear Networks LLC, doing business as Kingdom Fiber, as the Internet Service Provider for the Craftsbury Broadband Network. Motion moved.

Road Foreman's Report:

Steve absent, no report given.

Clerk's Report:

Yvette still hasn't received a bill yet for the broadband work, hopefully she will get one soon, so reimbursement can be received before the fire truck is due. Yvette reminded the Selectboard they may have to borrow.
