### Approve Minutes Last Meeting:

### Animal Control Officer:

Chris Masse' has stepped down as Animal Control Officer. Emily Thompson applied for the Animal Control Officer and the Selectboard accepted her application. Phil offered to send Bruce statewide animal resources that he had after attending a presentation. Michelle will bring the most recent animal control draft they were working on to the next meeting. The Selectboard will invite Emily to the next Selectboard meeting.

### Gravel Pit Contract:

Bruce will work on setting up an appointment with the Mellets and town crew about the Gravel Pit.

### Beach Request:

Lisa Santamore requested a garbage can, load of sand and cigarette buckets for the Town Beach. Jim will ask Kent to bring in a load of sand. Lisa can use one of the Town Garage garbage cans, and they will look into some buckets for cigarettes.

### Committees:

Jenny thanked the Selectboard for all the road safety measures done. They received an estimate of \$2217.60 for fog lines down the Common hill, more than expected. Bruce said they were hoping to get paving done in July, the Wild Branch will be completed first, then the remained on the Common Hill. Kent is hoping to repaint the crosswalk lines in next few weeks. Bruce said right now Kent is the only road crew person working this week though because Steve is on vacation.

Molly said she did an informal test with 100 cars going north and south by her property, average speed was 40 miles per hour.

Clerk's Report:

Town Clerk's office will be closed June 28, Betty and Yvette will be going to Legislative breakfast in Newport.

Yvette mentioned that Thursday, June 21 is a luncheon presentation regarding legalization of marijuana.
