Approve Minutes Last Meeting:

Jim made a motion to approval the Sep. 4, 2018 minutes as printed, approved.

Dog Complaint:

Barb explained what happened when she recently got bit by a dog while running. The Selectboard discussed the process of what happens if someone is confronted with an aggressive dog and also updated the Flints on the status of the dog.
