Approve Minutes Last Meeting:

Jim a motion to approve the April 9, 2019 minutes with the one correction, seconded and approved.

ATV Special Meeting Discussion on April 30th:

A special meeting for discussion on an ATV ordinance was held April 30, 2019. Present was Frank Halden, David Rodgers, Elinor Osborn, Steve Wright, Dwight Denton, Carol Maroni, Penelope Doherty, Paul Gruhler, and June Cook.

Bistro Crosswalk:

Leanne Kinsey and the Sedores had asked if the town could put in a crosswalk to go from their new Bistro to the overflow parking lot across the parking lot. Bruce will double check at an upcoming meeting on requirements.

Coloring the Kingdom:

The Selectboard received and approved a request from Wonder Arts Ceilidh-Kane, for the annual Coloring the Kingdom. It will be held July 4th from 9-11 AM, starting at Dustan Field. Yvette will let Ceilidh know.

Committee Reports and Appointees:

Susan invited the other Selectboard to attend the public forum for the future of the Academy Woodlot on Wednesday, May 15th at 7 PM in the Common Room.

Susan said that Steve Moffatt is the new chair on the Conservation Commission. They are working on pollinators.

Susan mentioned that Linda Ramsdell and Davide Rowell are on the Planning Commission's subcommittee on housing in Craftsbury.

Road Foreman's Report:

Jim mentioned they sold the body of the town pickup truck.

The Selectboard is planning to pave from the trailer on the right (past the intersection of Mill Village Road and N. Craftsbury Road) as far as the \$60,000 will go down N. Craftsbury Road, and maybe skim the Village bridge too.

Bruce said they have finished the surveying on the Bridge in the Village.

The Selectboard discussed the white lines from the Village to the Common. They need to verify with Jenny on the Road Safety Committee Plan A and Plan B, depending how far they can go financially.

Clerk's Report:

Yvette reported they are low on funds this time of year until tax money comes in.

ATV Ordinance:

The Selectboard discussed an ATV Ordinance for Craftsbury (see attached ordinance). **Jim made a motion to approve the temporary ATV Ordinance for Craftsbury, Susan seconded, motion approved.**
