Tentative Schedule:

Things To Bring:

- Your **current membership card** & record book. **NO CARD = NO PARTICIPATION. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- A clean judo gi (preferably 2 gis), any individual with a dirty, smelly, or poorly maintained gi will be not be permitted to participate. Wash your gi & repair all tears and holes in it before you arrive.
- A towel to dry yourself as needed during the breaks
- Footwear - zori, slippers, sandals, & etc. to keep your feet clean, anyone with dirty feet or walking off the tatami without footwear will be dismissed from the training session.
- Have & demonstrate good personal hygiene, respect, and appreciation for yourself and others. **KEEP YOUR BODY, FEET, & JUDO GI CLEAN!**

Instructors:

- Please be sure that all participants from your dojo are VERY proficient in ukemi and willing to take a lot of falls for everyone.
- Please **NO BEGINNERS**
- It is assumed that your students should be doing kata and conditioning work.
- Please be sure that your students have sufficient exposure and experience with kata and proper etiquette and manners.
- **Please let the appropriate project manager know what your estimated head count will be before a clinic.** That gives the project manager an opportunity to plan for an accurate number of participants.

Fees: There is a one-time \$20 fee for each or all clinic (s). Checks payable to SIJI. Please feel free to make a donation to the hosts as well.

Meals: On your own.

In 1971, Campbell Sensei moved to Colorado and passed the title of head instructor of the Sacramento Judo Club to Makimoto Sensei. Makimoto Sensei served as the head instructor at the Sacramento Judo Club for 25 years until his departure in 1996.

Three months later, he opened the Okubo Judo Club. Over the years, the Okubo Judo Club formed affiliations with the Sacramento Asian Police Officers Association (APOA) and the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Sacramento.

Makimoto Sensei has produced hundreds of Judo champions throughout the years.

1. I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.

2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
