## Annual Report 2013

### 2013 Medical Program Accomplishments

- Served more than 36,000 patients, a 16% decrease from last year.
- Offered round-the-clock emergency services, treating 2,716 patients (2,691 cases were treated at our own hospital, while only 25 cases were transported to city hospitals for specialized care.)
- Provided 24/7 service with two ambulances in a 30-mile radius.
- Housed 616 patients at our 12-bed hospital.
- Performed 109 surgeries.
- Delivered 35 babies.
- Conducted 270 lab tests.
- Treated 34 tuberculosis patients with full course of treatment (treatments can take up to 9 months), down 70 % from 2012. (This resulted from a new partnership with the government; we returned to the original method in 2014.)



### 2013 Prevention Program Accomplishments

- Added 12 new villages to the prevention program, increasing the total number of villages being served to 60.
- Served 8 kindergarten schools in our prevention program, a 33% increase.
- Supplied 2,050 children with nutritional supplements and vaccinations.
- Provided 601 pregnant women with prenatal care, nutritional supplements and vaccinations, up from 366 in 2012, a cumulative 300% increase in two years.
- Conducted 576 health education seminars in 36 villages, up from 432 in 2011.
- Increased family planning program significantly:
  - ✓ Visited 7,484 pregnancy-age women throughout the year on a bimonthly, rotating basis for one-on-one meetings to build relationships and provide family planning consultations.
  - ✓ Distributed 11,1267 condoms and 207,900 birth control pills in our family planning program
  - ✓ Counseled and transported 389 women to the Block Government Hospital for tubal ligation.

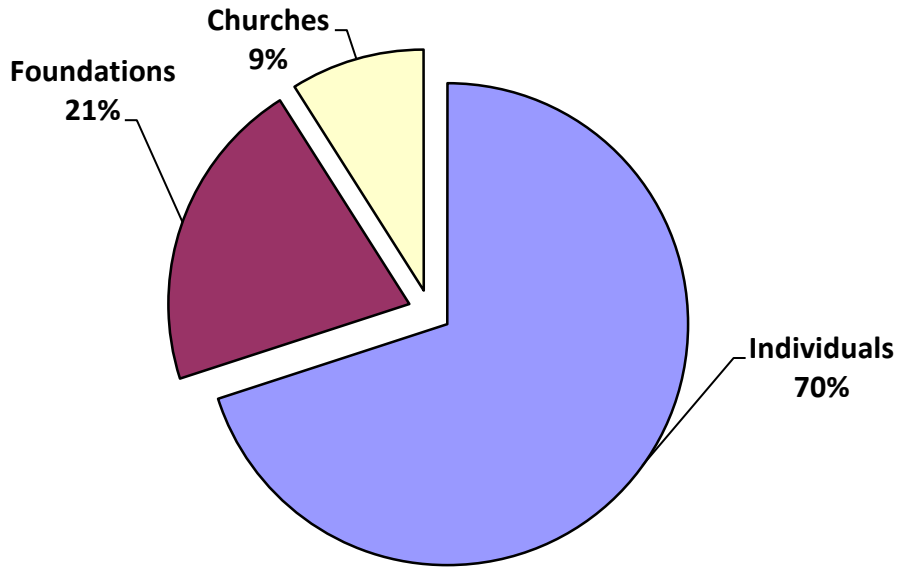

### New for 2014

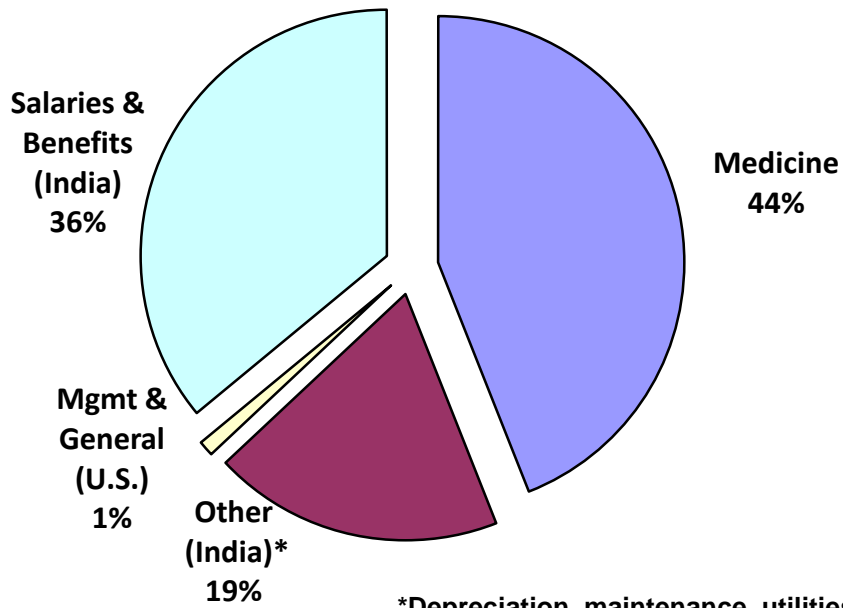
- Constructed toilets for 14 local schools; 10 more schools are planned for 2014. This project is expected to reduce girls' dropout rates.
- Perform 300 cataract surgeries.
- Awarded 6 new scholarships in 2014 at the Nandeshwar Bal Vidya School in a program that was started in 2011.
