Annual Report 2015

2015 Medical Program Accomplishments

- Served 33260 patients.
- Offered round-the-clock emergency services, treating 1700 patients, (1682 cases were treated at our own hospital, while only 18 cases were transported to city hospitals for specialized care).
- Provided 24/7 service with two ambulances in a 30-mile radius.
- Housed 364 patients at our 12-bed hospital.
- Performed 57 surgeries.
- Delivered 52 babies.
- Conducted 37 lab tests.
- Treated 41 tuberculosis patients with full course of treatment (treatment can take up to 9 months).



2015 Prevention Program Accomplishments

- Served 60 villages in the prevention program.
- Served 8 kindergarten schools in our prevention program.
- Supplied 1788 children with nutritional supplements and vaccinations.
- Provided 456 pregnant women with prenatal care, nutritional supplements and vaccinations.
- Conducted 720 health education seminars in 60 villages.
- Family Planning Results:
 - ✓ Visited 8910 pregnancy-age women throughout the year on a monthly, rotating basis for one-on-one meetings to build relationships and provide family planning consultation.
 - ✓ Provided condoms to 3,439 women, Mala-D contraception to 1187, Copper-T to 126 and multi-load to 110 women in our family planning program.
 - ✓ Counseled and transported 428 women to the Block Government Hospital for tubal ligation.

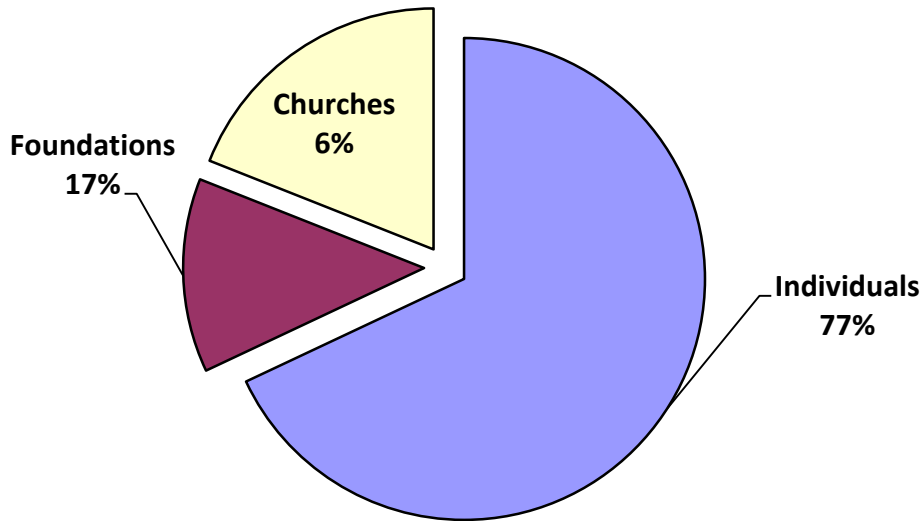
Other Programs in 2015

- Provided 51 cataract surgeries.
- Continued the scholarship program, started in 2011 at the NandeshwarBalVidya School; 6 new students received scholarships in 2014.
- Distributed 20 tricycles to handicapped men and women.
- Distributed blankets to 65 poor villagers this winter.

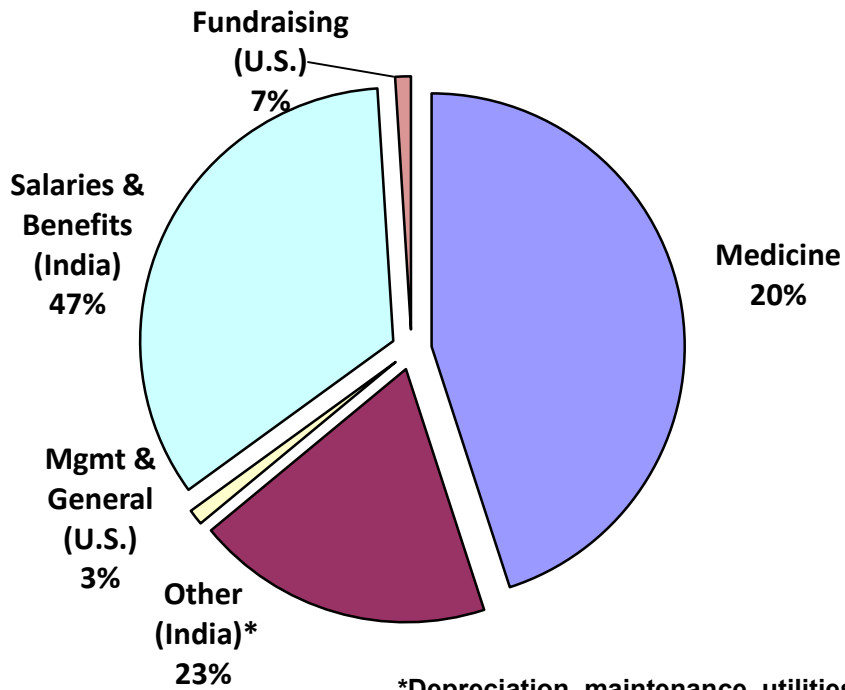
