Directions:

Directions to the campground meeting area for the Clark Fork are as follows...

From Coeur d'Alene, Take I-90 East (all freeway miles) to Lozeau/Quartz Exit 55. At the bottom of the off ramp of Lozeau /Quartz exit 55, take a left and go approximately 1/8 mile down steep hill followed by your first hard right and look for the Wiley E. Waters sign to the left for parking. The official address in case you would like to Google it is: 201 William Lloyd Ln, Superior, Mt 59872. Note: Lozeau Quartz Exit is 55 miles into Montana from the Idaho border. Allow 2 hour drive from Coeur d'Alene . We meet a 9:00AM Pacific time. Please note that Montana is Mountain Time, but we still keep our schedule on Pacific Standard Time of 9:00 AM.

Note: Lozeau is 55 miles into Montana from the Idaho border. **We meet at 9:00 AM Pacific time.** Please note that Montana is Mountain Time, but we still keep our schedule on **Pacific Time of 9:00 AM. (Spokane time).** At approximately **2:30 PM PST**, we will be back at the "take out" point. A deli bar lunch will be served along a designated "pull-over" area during the trip.

Allow 2-3 hours, at 70 -75 miles an hour, from Spokane (leaving around 6:00 am) to get to the meeting location. The drive consists of all freeway miles on Interstate 90.

CAMPING INFORMATION

A suggestion we give all our campers is that there is a larger, more scenic campground called "Trout Creek" off Superior exit 47, that might accommodate larger groups more comfortably than ours. Also they are affordably priced at \$6 a vehicle, beautiful creek, landscape and friendly hosts. That is an additional option we inform everyone of, because our location can become crowded.
