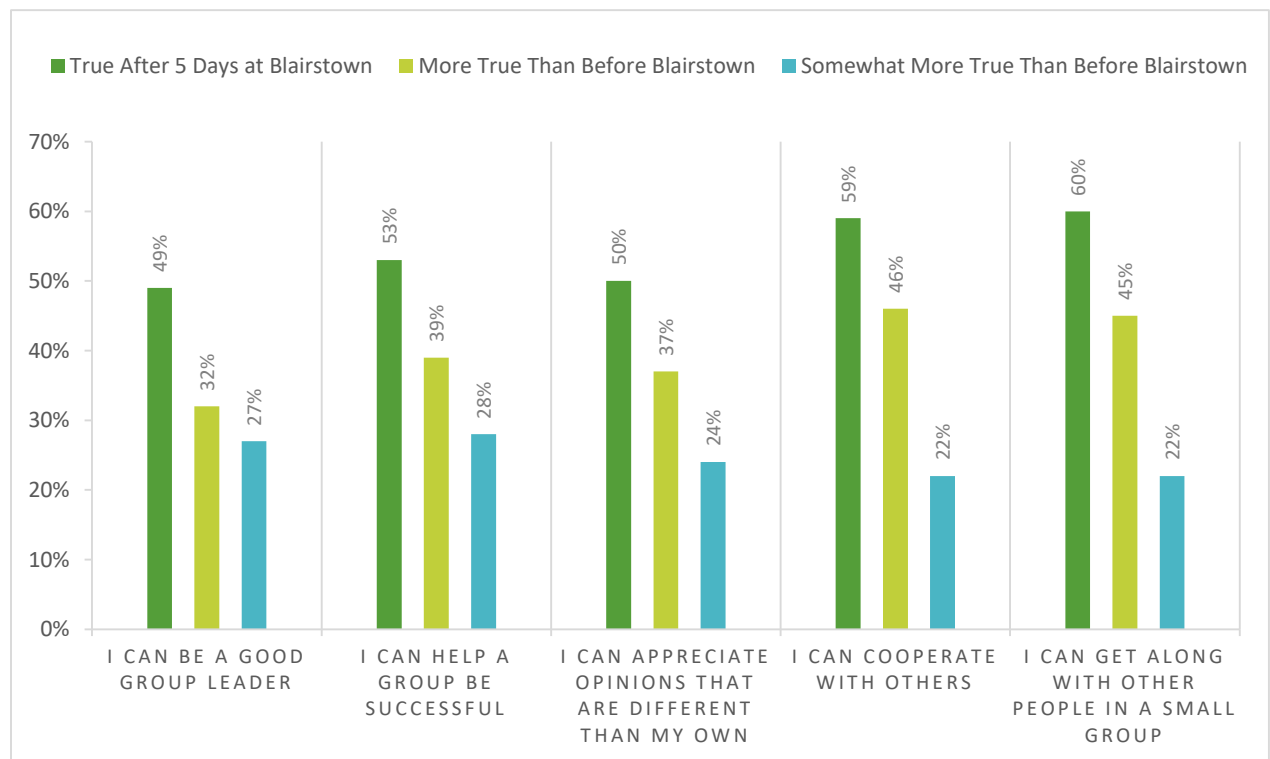




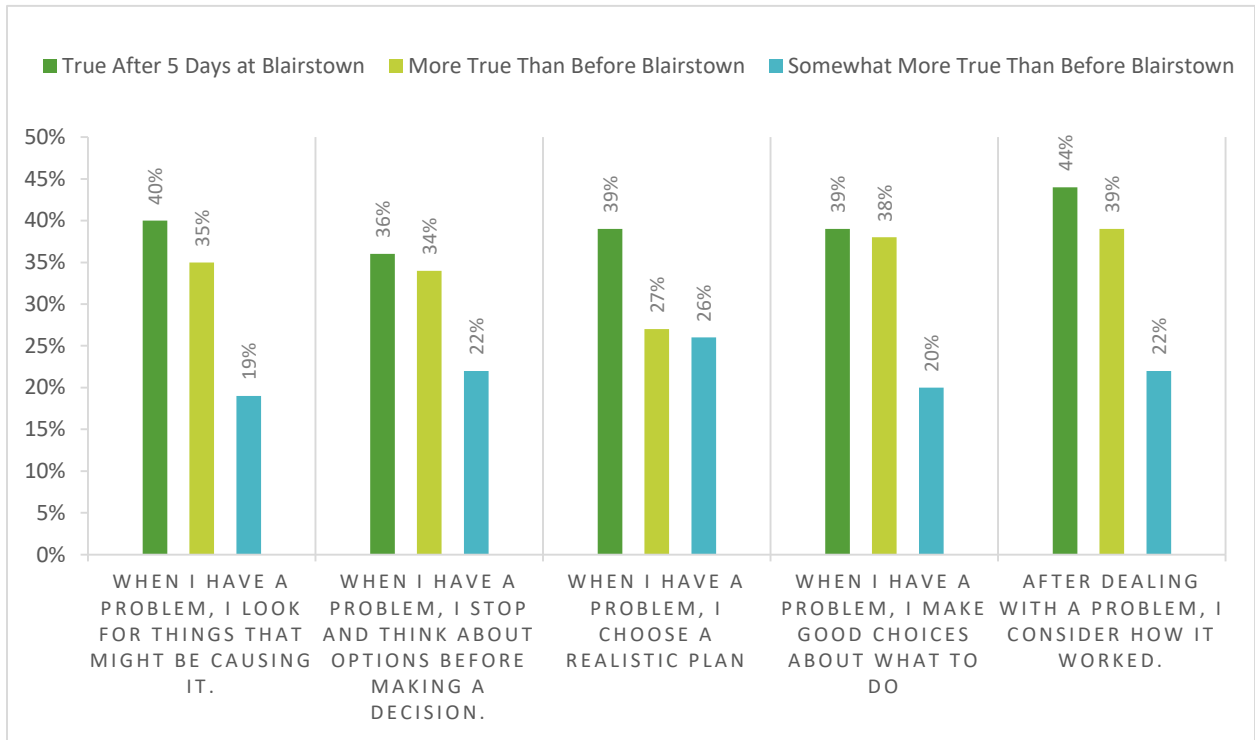
A TOTAL OF 233 PARTICIPANTS OUT OF 247 COMPLETED THIS SURVEY AFTER PBC'S 2016 SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM – A MAJORITY OF PARTICIPANTS WERE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 12 AND 13 YEARS OLD WITH A HANDFUL THAT WERE 9-11, OR 14-18. OF THE PARTICIPANTS, 58% WERE FEMALE AND 42% WERE MALE, 61% IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES AS AFRICAN-AMERICAN, 18% AS LATINO/A, AND 21% AS OTHER.

<b>Teamwork</b>	Nearly 50% felt more confident they could be a good leader. More than half felt they could be more effective in helping a group be successful.
<b>Problem-Solving Confidence</b>	40% were more likely to look for what might be causing their problem.
<b>Affinity for Nature</b>	60% enjoy the freedom of the outdoors.
<b>Responsibility</b> <i>Cohort A (102 Participants)</i>	Nearly three-quarters accept responsibility for their actions and more than half don't blame others for their mistakes.
<b>Interest in Exploration (Healthy Risk-Taking)</b> <i>Cohort B (131 Participants)</i>	More than half want to visit places different from where they live. Nearly three-quarters want to learn more about new ideas.

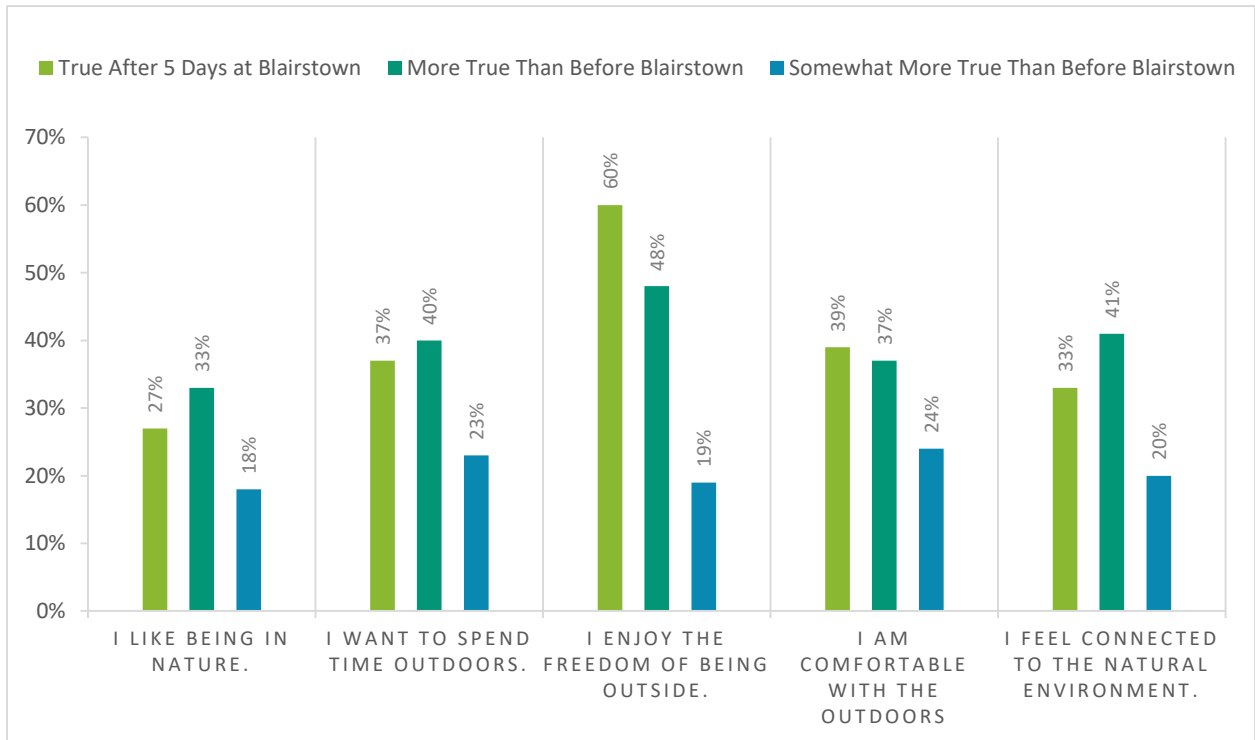

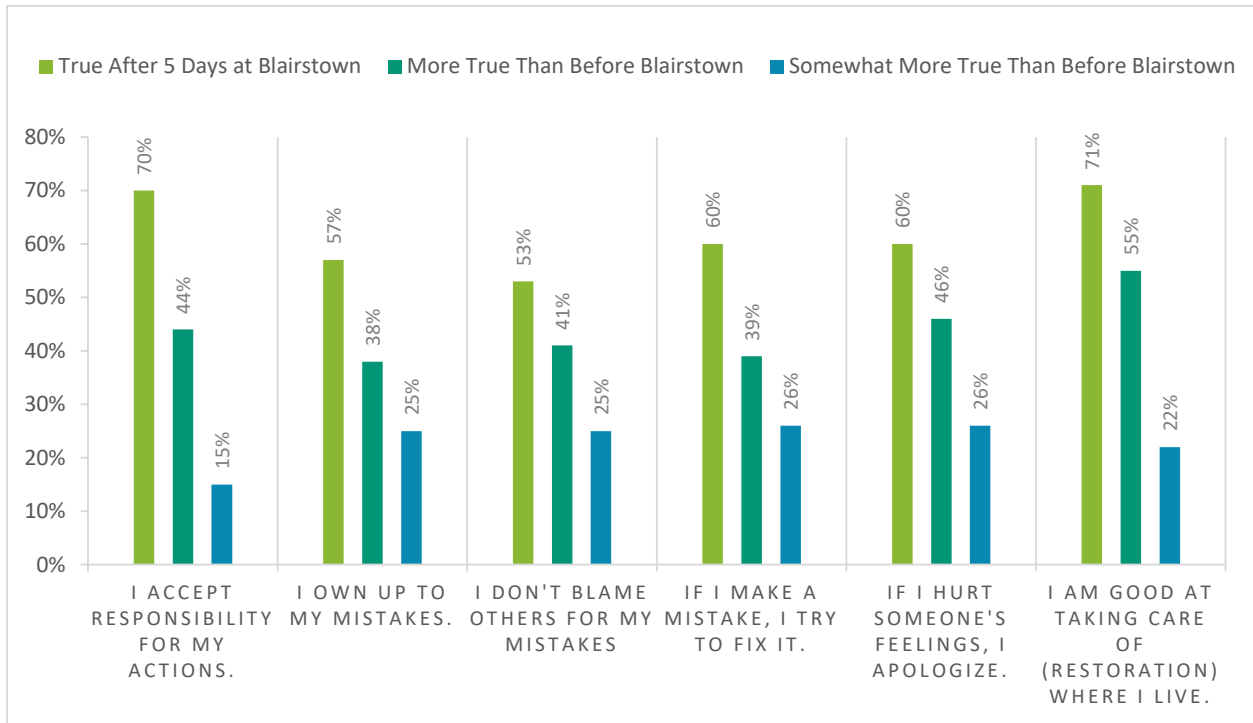
