

WEF STUDY GRANT - Terms and Conditions

The Award

Study grants are for **new students** commencing **September 2017**:

- as a one-time start-up financial assistance.
- to subsidise **tuition fees** only up to a maximum of RM600.

Who can apply?

Candidates must fulfill the following requirements:

- Malaysian citizens.
- NEW STUDENTS admitted to Wawasan Open University degree programme.
- Minimum education qualification of SPM or equivalent.
- Students with prior degree qualification(s) are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply.
- Family Basic Income of NOT MORE than RM7,000 per month or RM84,000 per annum.
- Provide clear proof and evidence to support education qualification, parents' / guardian's income declaration or unemployment declaration.

Note : Fulfillment of minimum requirements DOES NOT GUARANTEE successful award of the WEF Study Grant. Award is based on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS.

How to apply?

Where to apply?

Completed WEF Study Grant application forms must be submitted to: Regional Centre / Regional Support Centre of Wawasan Open University where you have enrolled.

When to apply?

Closing date for the study grant application is **3rd September 2017**. Late applications shall not be entertained.

When will the results be announced?

Results of the study grant applications are scheduled to be announced, tentatively by **16th October 2017**.

Terms and Conditions

1. Study grants are awarded in accordance to the established criteria and the decision of the Award Committee is **FINAL**.
2. Study grants awarded but not used for the semester cannot be retained by the student and shall therefore be deemed to be forfeited, **except for students who are deferring their studies**.
3. This study grant is a "one-time" financial assistance valid for the semester in which it is offered and it is not renewable for subsequent semesters, **except for students who are deferring their studies**.
4. Study grant is neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash.
5. Study grants awarded are subject to the availability of funds.
6. The University reserves the right to revoke the award if the student fails to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the University or if falsified information is found to be furnished by the applicant to manipulate the outcome of the grant.
7. The Award Committee reserves the right to offer study grants for full or part of the grant amount if it is deemed appropriate.
8. Fulfillment of minimum requirements **DOES NOT GUARANTEE** successful award of the WEF Study Grant. Award is based on a first come first serve basis.
9. At any time, a student shall not be permitted to receive more than one scholarship/grant simultaneously from the University and, if so, the University reserves the right to revoke the awards immediately.
