

2017 Turley "Kirschenmann Vineyard" Zinfandel, Lodi

Owned by our winemaker Tegan Passalacqua, these ungrafted vines were planted in 1915 in the sandy soils of the east side of the Mokelumne River AVA. Thanks to the river's cool waters and delta breezes, these headtrained, field-blend vines—including Mondeuse, Cinsault, and Carignane are constantly protected from the heat.

Bright and high-toned notes of red cherries, citrus and blood orange, along with ripe peaches and other stone fruits on the nose. The palate is signature Kirschnenmann: excellent acidity, suave tannins, and profound depth, with a lightly chalky, well-structured finish.
