

2017 Turley "Duarte," Zinfandel, Contra Costa County

This wine is comprised of fruit from the turn-of-the-century Evangehlo, Mori and Salvador vineyards, planted between 1890 and 1930. Because of the sandy soils and impressive age of the vines, the wine has some of the softest, silkiest tannins we've ever seen in a Zinfandel. Savory, alluring, and profound on the nose, with dark fruit notes, sandalwood, rhubarb, and whole black peppercorns. Suave tannins and excellent depth on the palate; we found the wine much more expressive with a quick decant, or it will likely age well if you have more patience than we do!
