

2017 Turley "Dusi Vineyard," Zinfandel, Paso Robles

Planted by Dante Dusi in 1945 and head-trained and farmed by his family to this day, the Dusi vines produce some of the richest and most distinctive wines in Paso Robles.

Immediately expressive on the nose: vivid red fruits, chalky soils, and fresh cherry sap, with a hint of Poblano pepper in the background. Satiating and rich on the palate, with a nice boost from the acidity; Larry wants to drink it with "a dish of wild game in a cooked red berry or cherry sauce."



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
